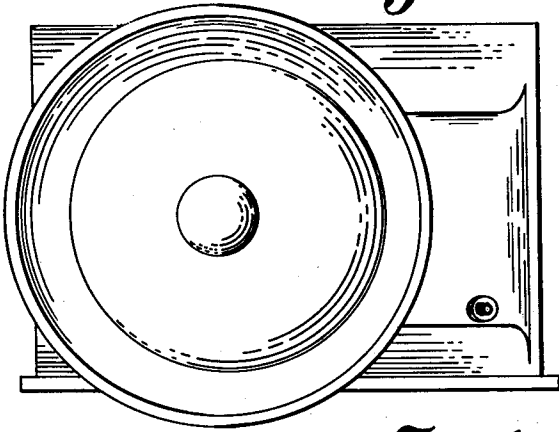
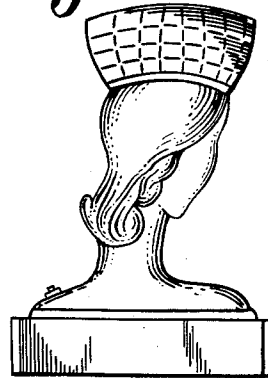

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John C. Balyozian, a citizen of the United States, residing at Arlington, in the county of Middlesex, in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Electric Lamp or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of an electric lamp or similar article, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a top plan view thereof, and

Figure 3 is a rear elevational view.
