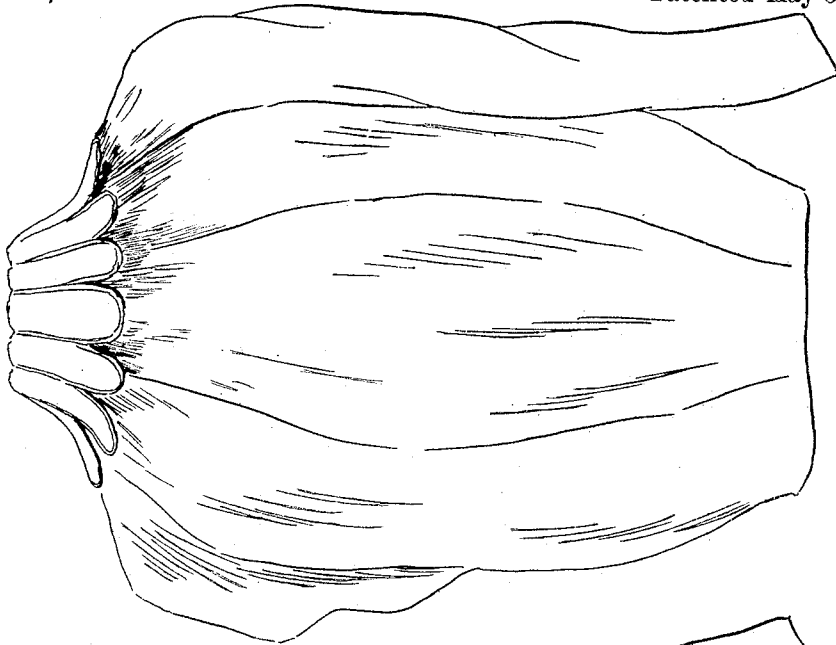

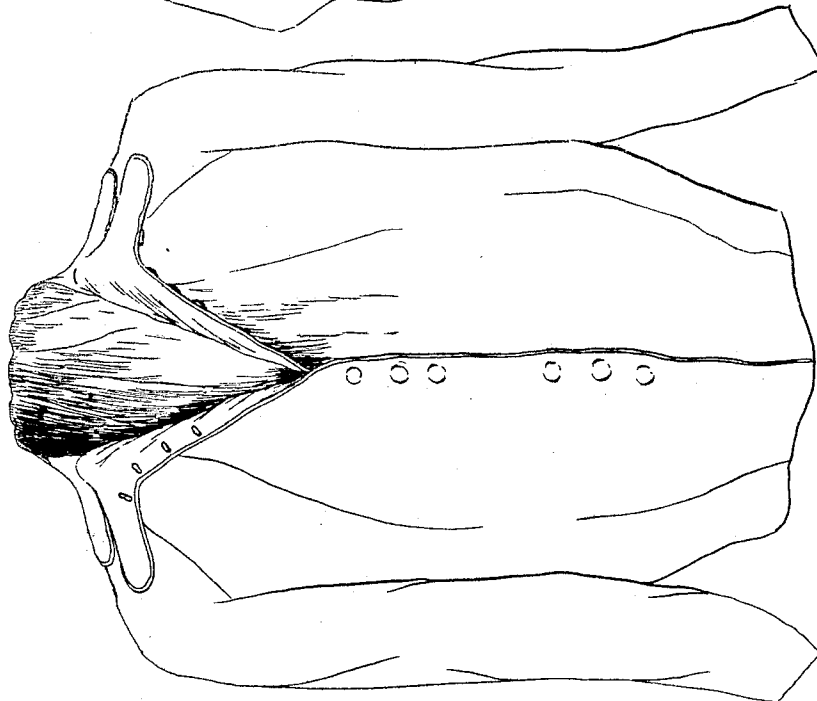

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, FELICJA GRINUCH, a citizen of France, residing in the borough of Manhattan, city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Shirt-Waists, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front view of a shirtwaist showing my new design, and Fig. 2 is a rear view of the shirtwaist.
