DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 15,110, dated July 1, 1884.

Application filed May 22, 1884. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES M. CONNER, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and it consists of an unshaded ornamental letter, the upper part of which, as in the case of the C, D, G, O, Q, R, and symbol "and," is rounded, while the lower or base of the letters is square and

pointed. The C, E, F, G, J, L, Q, S, T, and Z are ornamented by the curved line with dot termination, as shown.

The character of the design is preserved in the numerals and lower-case, as shown.

Having described my invention, I claim as new—

The design for a font of printing-type, as shown and described.
