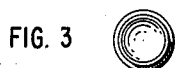
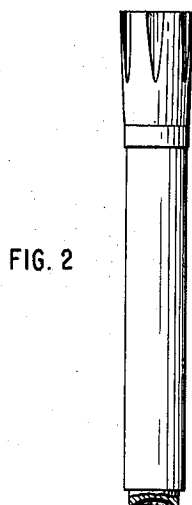


FIG. 1 is a top view;
