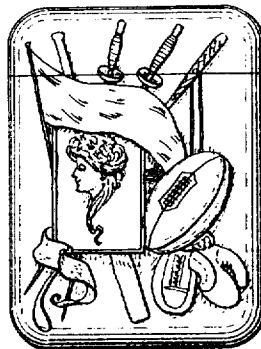
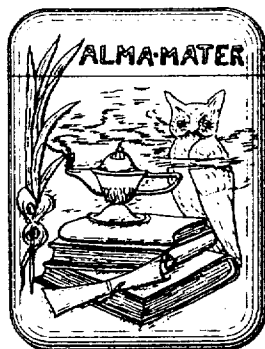

## DESIGN FOR A MATCH-BOX OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 37,212, dated November 8, 1904.

Application filed October 10, 1904. Serial No. 227,958. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, SIDNEY A. KELLER, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Match-Box or Similar Article, reference being had to the accompanying drawings.
