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(54) Title: METHOD OF PREVENTING ADHESIONS WITH IFN- γ

(57) Abstract: Methods for the prevention of adhesion formation and development involve the administration of therapeutic formulations to a patient which include, as active ingredients, IFN- γ or IFN- γ enhancers. The IFN- γ or IFN- γ enhancers are preferably administered to fibrosis tissues in a subject prior to an event which induces adhesion formation, such as a surgical event.
