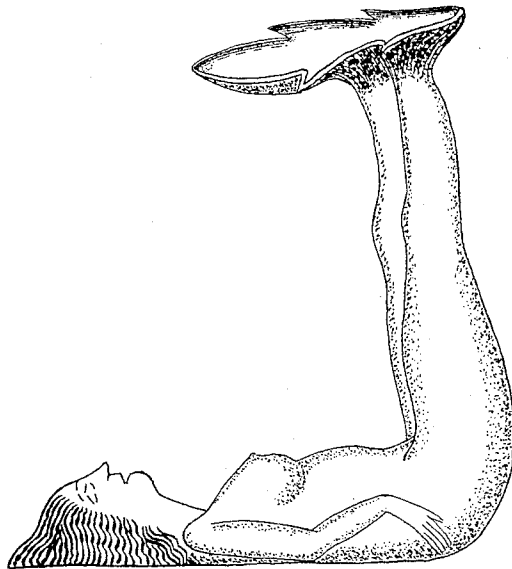
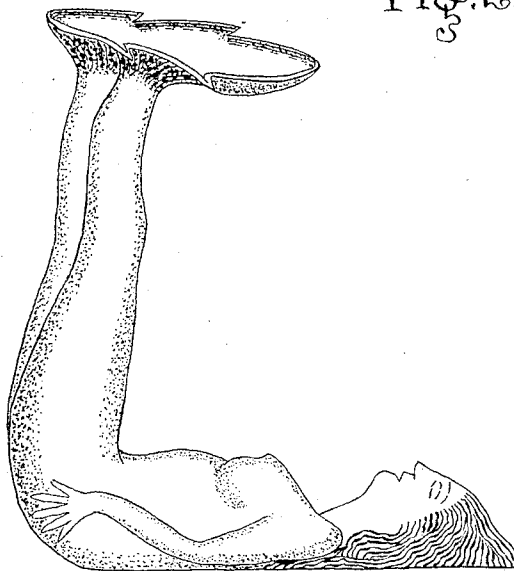

DESIGN FOR A PEDESTAL

Application filed August 24, 1931. Serial No. 40,917. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, McCLELLAND BARCLAY, a citizen of the United States, residing at No. 730 Fifth Avenue, New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pedestal, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
