

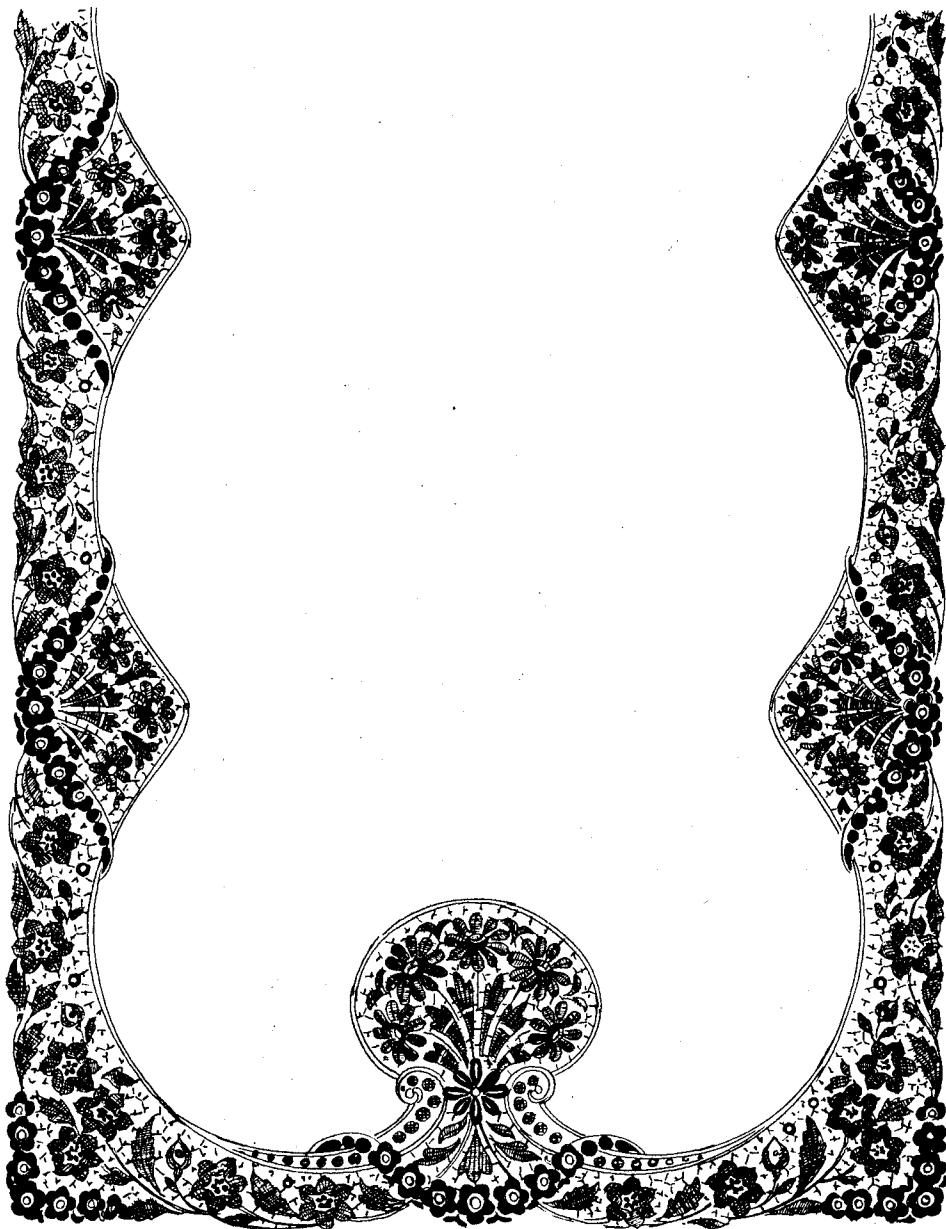

DESIGN FOR LACE TRIMMING FOR DOILY OR THE LIKE.

Application filed January 10, 1928. Serial No. 24,800. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LAWRENCE DINKELSPIEL, a citizen of the United States, residing at West New York, county of Hudson, and State of New Jersey, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for Lace Trimming for Doily, or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of approximately one-half of lace trimming constituting my new design, the opposite end being a repetition of the end shown.
