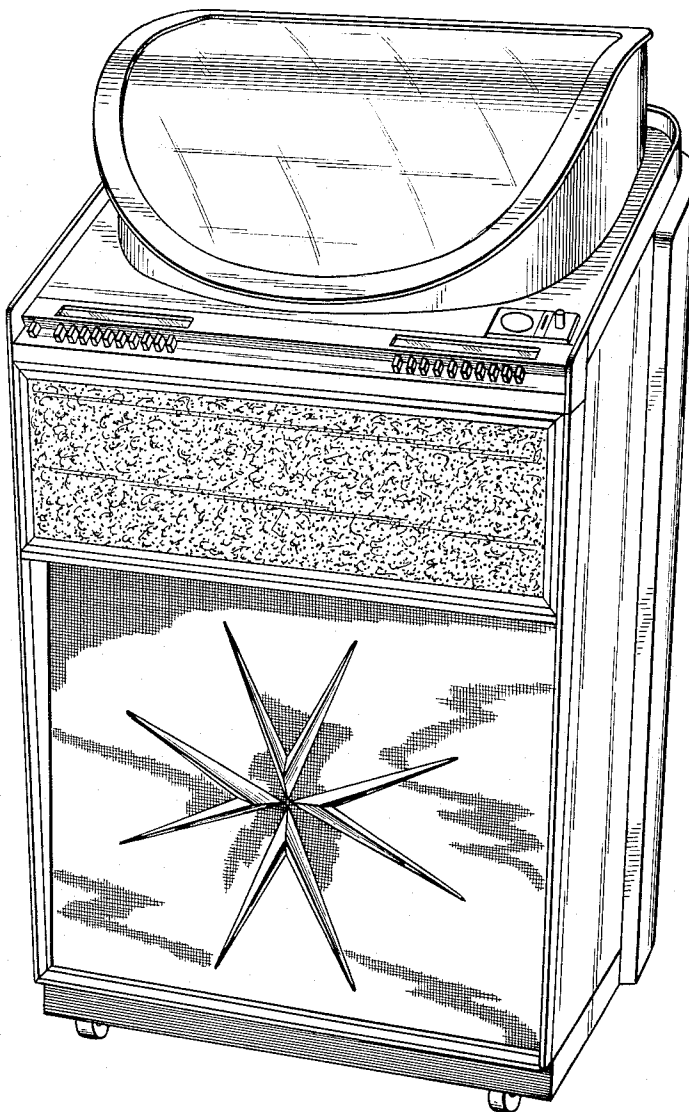

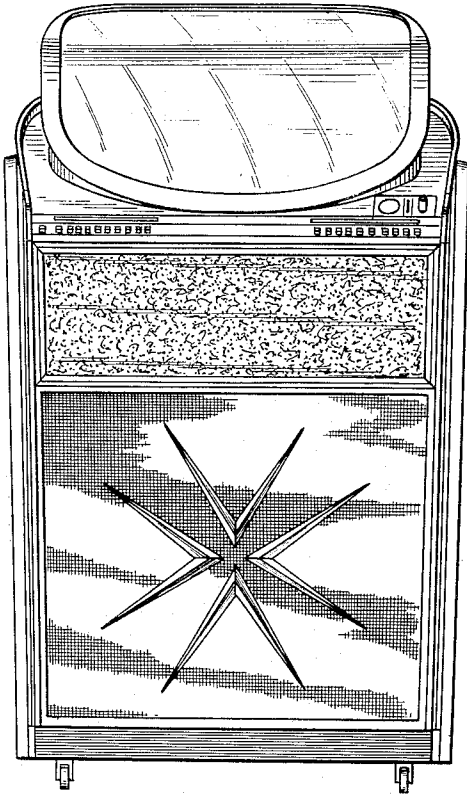

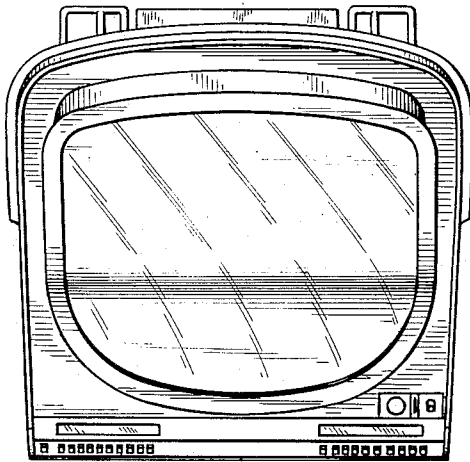
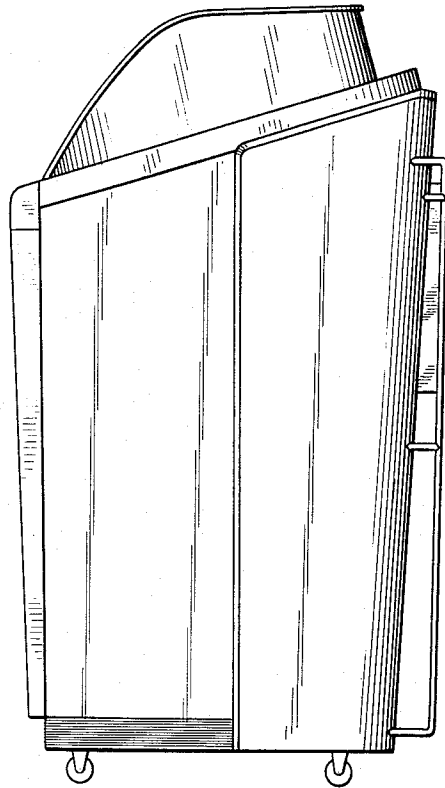

FIGURE 1 is a front perspective view of a phonograph cabinet showing my new design; FIGURE 2 is a reduced front elevational view; FIGURE 3 is a reduced side elevational view; and FIGURE 4 is a reduced plan view thereof. The side of the cabinet not shown is substantially the same as the side illustrated in FIGURE 3. The configuration of the back of the cabinet is substantially plain and unornamented, except for the hand rails shown.
