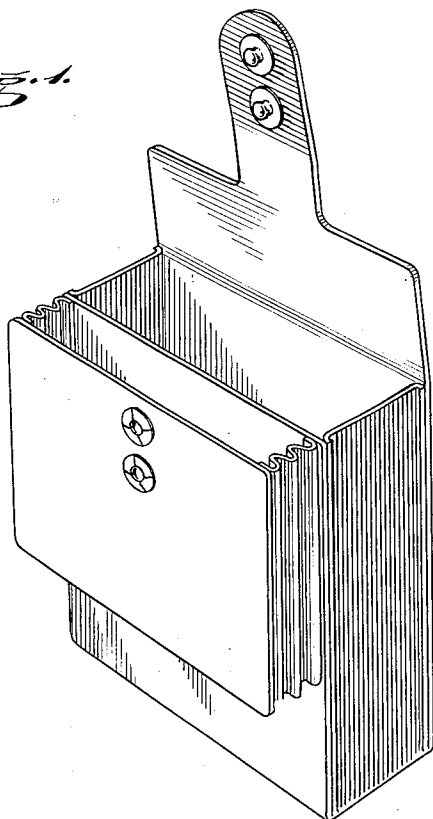

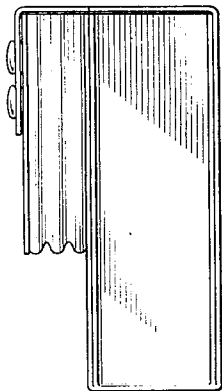
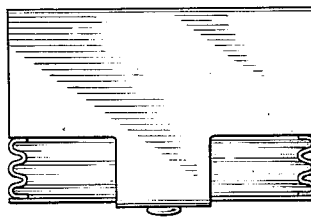

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Marcelle D'Orsay, a citizen of the United States and a resident of New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Cigarette and Cigarette Lighter Case, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part hereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a combined cigarette and cigarette lighter case, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is an end elevational view with the flap closed.

Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof.
