



DESIGN FOR A DECALCOMANIA TRANSFER SHEET.

Application filed June 11, 1926. Serial No. 18,008. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN O. HARTZ, a citizen of the United States, residing at Duluth, in the county of St. Louis and State of Minnesota, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Decalcomania Transfer Sheet, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a decalco-

mania transfer sheet, showing my new design. The shade lines appearing on the drawing are intended to represent the contrasted coloring green and blue.
