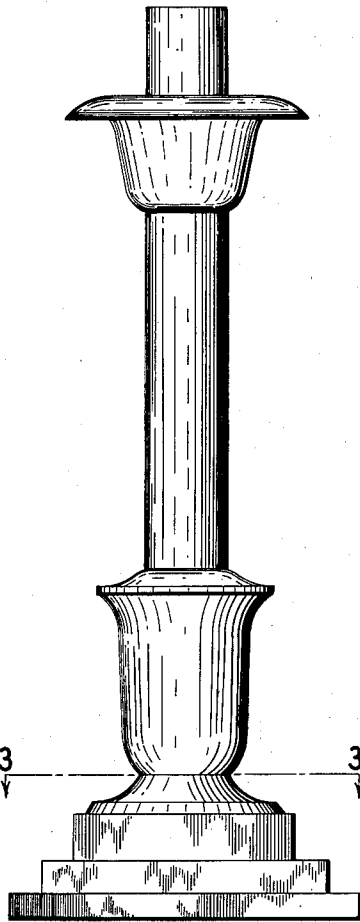

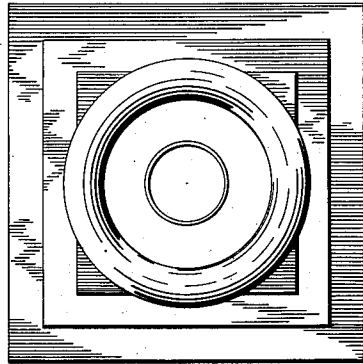

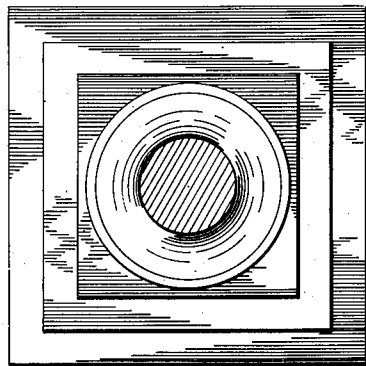

DESIGN FOR A CANDLESTICK

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Allan P. Lindblad, a citizen of the United States, residing at Winchester, in the county of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Candlesticks, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is an elevational view of a candlestick, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a plan view of the same; and

Figure 3 is a section on the line 3—3 of Figure 1.
