












Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of a folding transparency viewer showing my new design and shown in an open or unfolded position;

Fig. 5 is a side elevational view thereof; and

Fig. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

Portions of the drawing figures are diagonally lined to indicate transparency.
