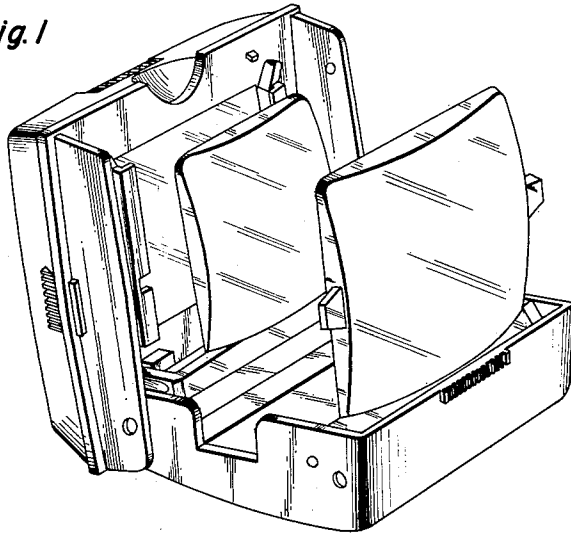

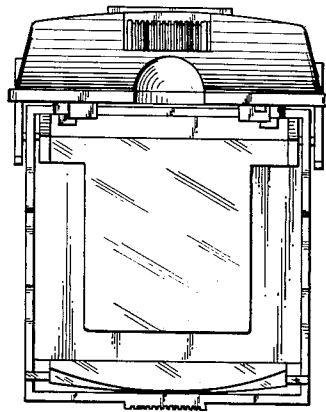


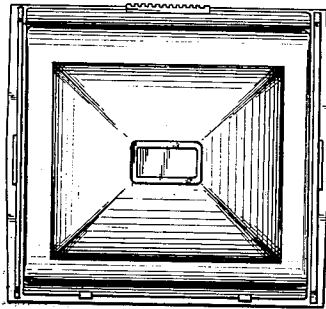
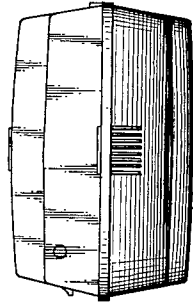
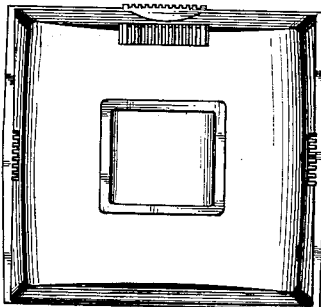
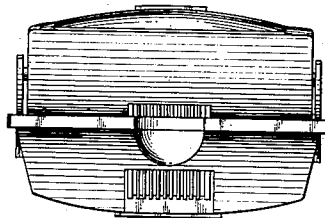
Fig. 3*Fig. 5**Fig. 4**Fig. 6*

Fig. 3 is a front elevational view thereof and shown in a folded position;

Fig. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

Fig. 5 is a side elevational view thereof; and

Fig. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

Portions of the drawing figures are diagonally lined to indicate transparency.
