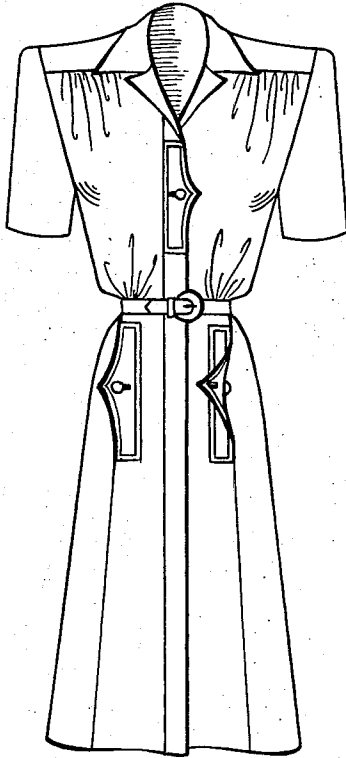

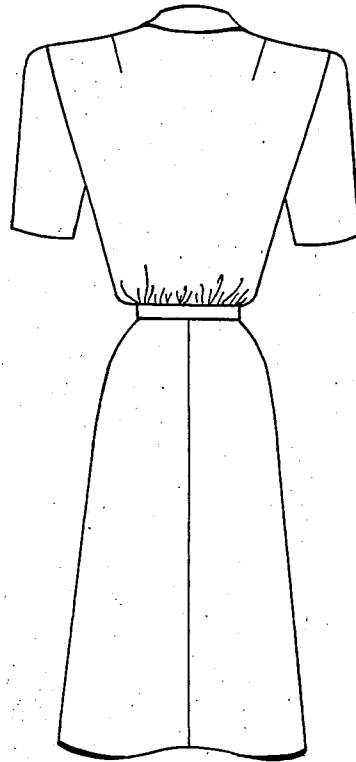

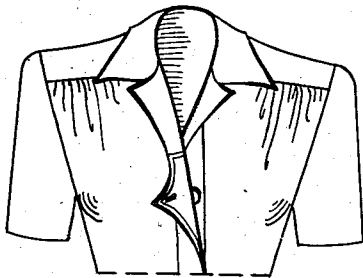

DESIGN FOR A DRESS

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Zelma Golden, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dress, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front view of a dress showing my design, with the skirt pocket member turned back for illustrative purposes.

Fig. 2 is the rear view of the dress shown in Fig. 1, and

Fig. 3 is a fragmentary front view of the dress shown in Fig. 1 illustrating the dress with the reverse member thereof in unbuttoned position.
