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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a transparent and translucent timepiece dial, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a transparent and translucent timepiece dial showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation shown in an alternate position;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevation shown in another alternate position;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation shown in another alternate position;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a front elevation of FIG. 4 shown with an unclaimed watchcase in broken lines;

FIG. 7 is a front elevation of FIG. 4 shown with different unclaimed environment;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged perspective view of the transparent and translucent timepiece dial shown in another position;

FIG. 9 is a front elevation of a second embodiment of the transparent and translucent timepiece dial;

FIG. 10 is a front elevation of the second embodiment shown in an alternate position;


FIG. 11 is a front elevation of the second embodiment shown in an alternate position;

FIG. 12 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along line 12—12 in FIG. 9; and,

FIG. 13 is a perspective view of the second embodiment shown in an alternate position.

The broken lines in the drawings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. Two of the three circular elements on the face of the timepiece dial are lined to indicate contrasting translucent colors. The smallest circular element on the face of the timepiece dial is stippled to indicate a contrasting translucent color. The views in the drawings are shown drawn on different scales.

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




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




