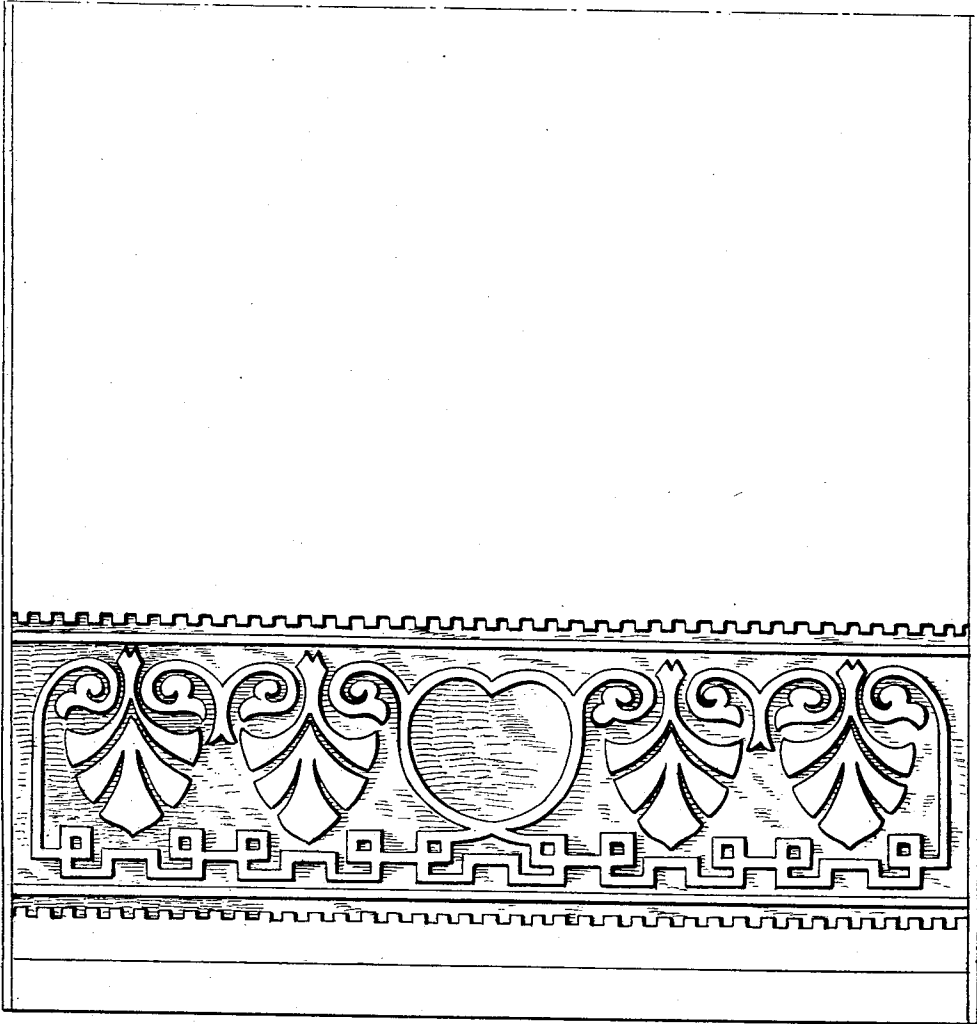

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HERMAN L. HOHLFELD, a citizen of the United States, residing at Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Turkish Towel or Mat, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a section, cut

transversely of a Turkish towel, superficially ornamented adjacent one edge and showing my new design.
