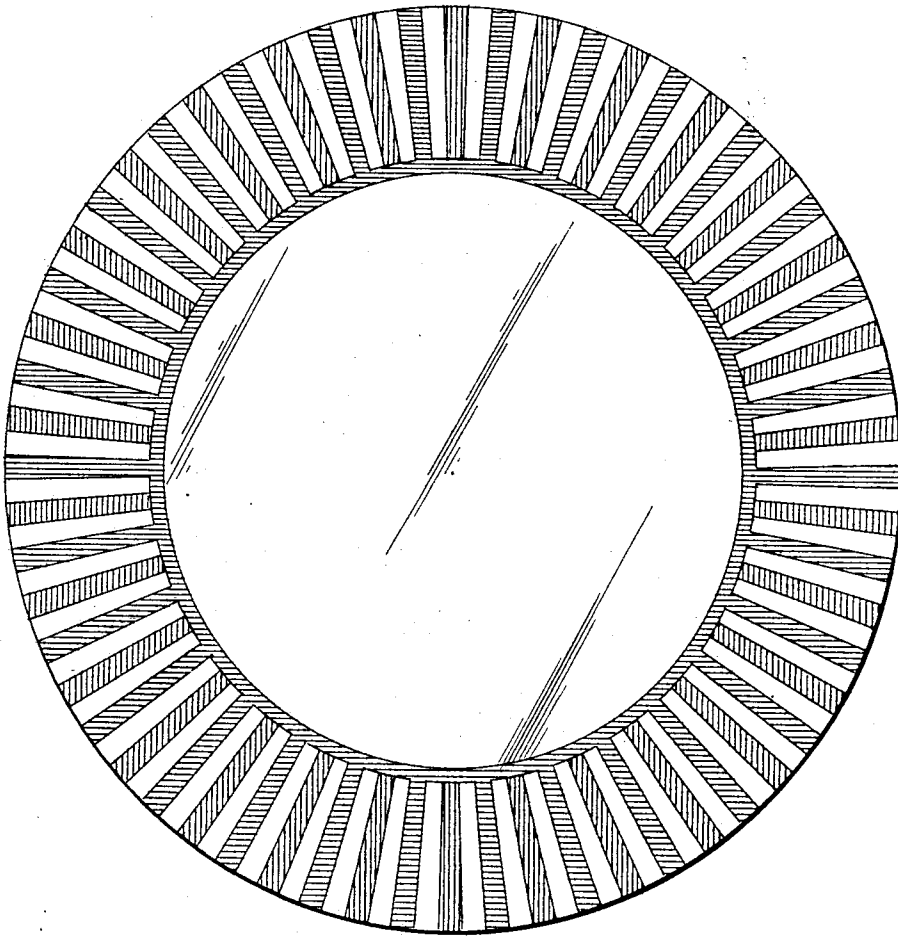

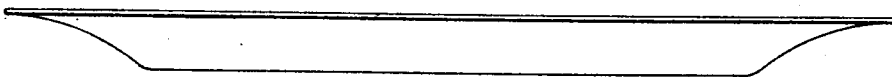

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that we, SAMUEL BUTT and JOSEPH BUTT, both citizens of the United States, and residents of the city of New York, borough of the Bronx, in the county of Bronx and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Plates and the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
