

DESIGN FOR A TOY STEAM-ENGINE.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WALTER HOLT, of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings, and State of New York, have invented a new and improved Design for Toy Steam-Engines; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, which will enable others skilled in the art to make and use the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part of this specification.

My design consists of a cylindrical vessel, A, mounted on legs, and having attached to the top or upper end an automaton figure, B, the hand or hands being connected with the crank of a wheel, C, whose axle is sup-

ported in standards D, all as shown in the accompanying drawing.

Having thus described my invention, I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

The design for toy steam-engines herein shown.
