(54) Title: NOVEL COSMETIC CREAM COMPOSITION COMPRISING C12-C20 FATTY ACID

(57) Abstract: Disclosed is a cosmetic cream base comprising: i) 4-10 % by weight C12-C20 fatty acid; ii) 1-5 % by weight fatty acid soap and iii) 2.5-10 % by weight particulate matter selected from talc, starch or its derivatives, and well as a cream composition comprising the cream base, and a method for improving the appearance of skin using the cream composition.
