
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a teller machine module, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a frontal perspective view of the teller machine module showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the second embodiment of FIG. 6;
 FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the second embodiment of FIG. 6.
 FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment of FIG. 6.

The right side elevational view not shown is identical with the left side elevational view shown. The rear of the through the wall automated teller machine module is plain and unornamented.


















