(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a knob for cooking utensil, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a knob for cooking utensil, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged right side view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is another further enlarged side elevational view thereof, taken from the right side of FIG. 2.










