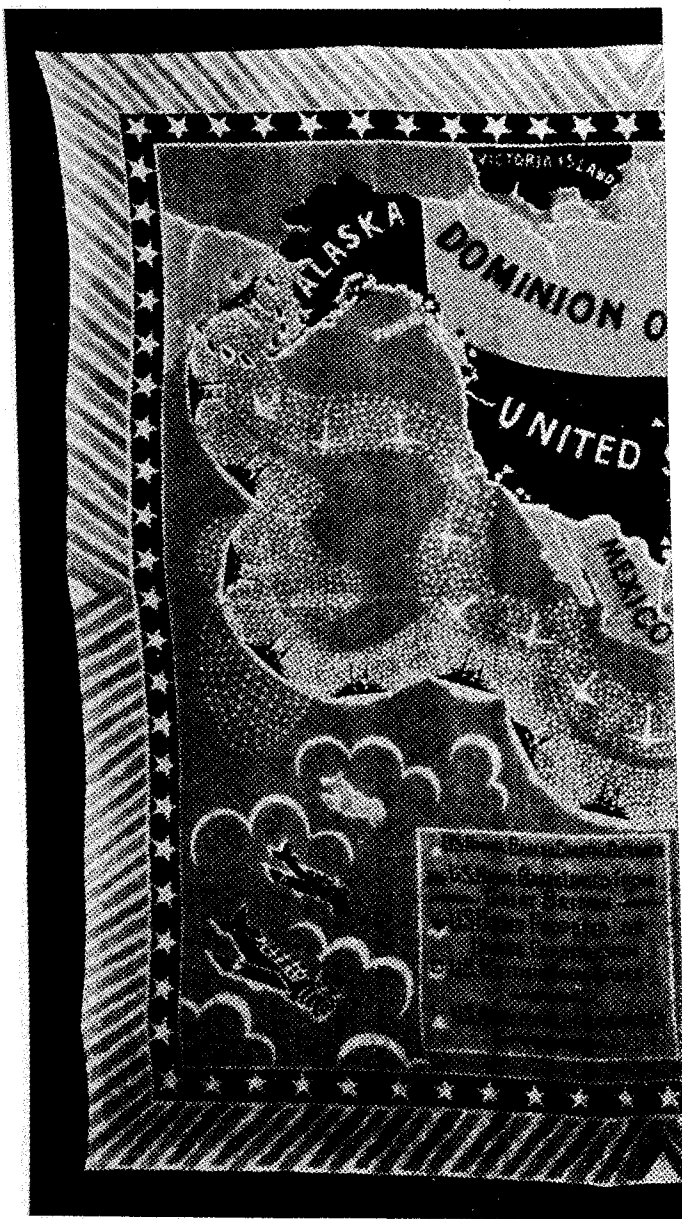

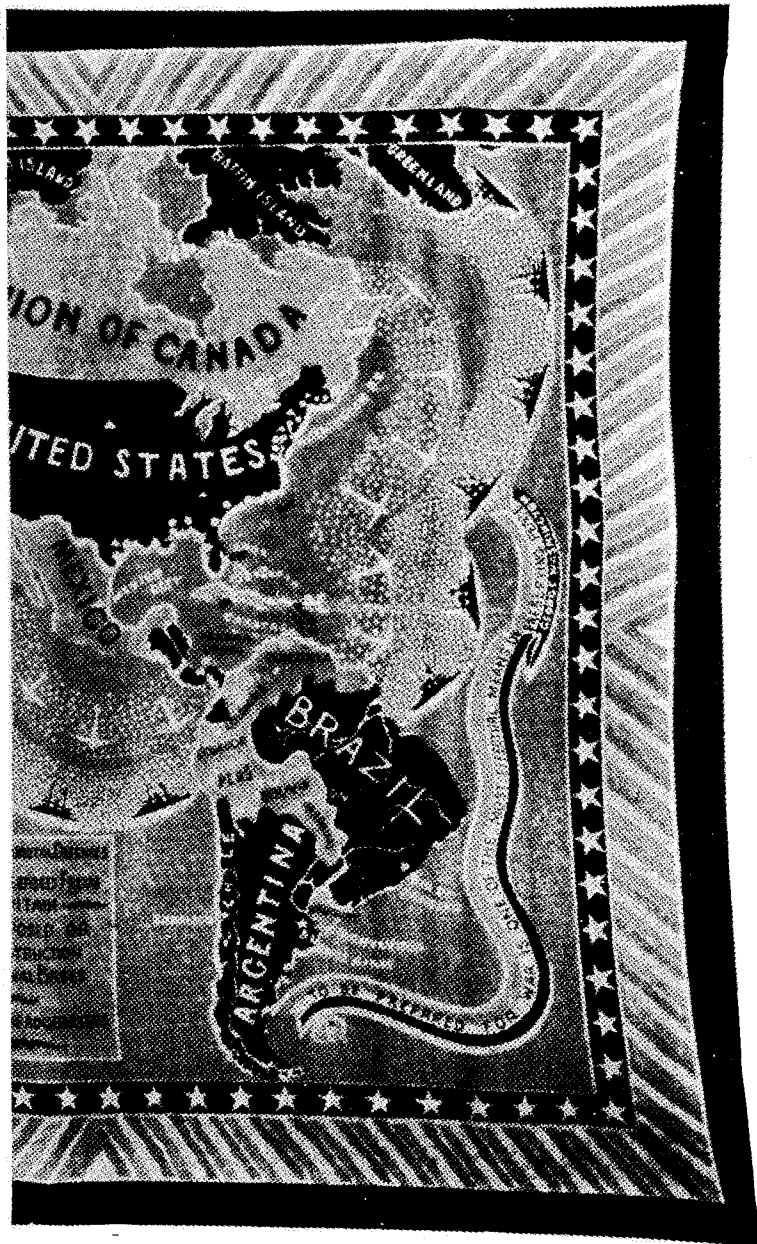

DESIGN FOR A SCARF OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Philip Goldenstein, Brooklyn, N. Y.

Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years

To whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Philip Goldenstein, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Scarf or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein

Figure 1 is a plan view of a scarf or similar article showing my new design; and

Figures 2 and 3 are, respectively, a right portion and a left portion, on an enlarged scale, for the purpose of bringing out more clearly the details thereof, of the scarf shown in Fig. 1.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a scarf or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
