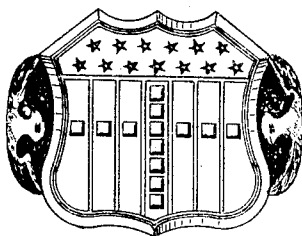

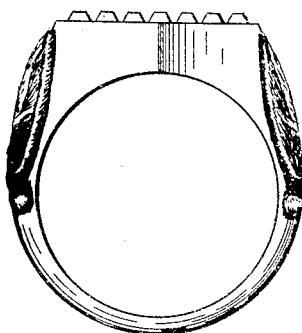
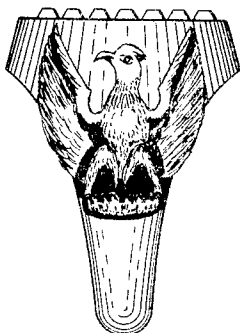

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR J. BEACOM, a citizen of the United States, residing at Omaha, in the county of Douglas and State of Nebraska, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Ring, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of the ring illustrating my new design. Fig. 2 is an end
