



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Carl L. Curt, a citizen of the United States residing at Boulder, State of Colorado, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for a Holder for Photographs or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a holder for photographs, embodying my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the holder of Fig. 1, with the frames in a slightly different position.
