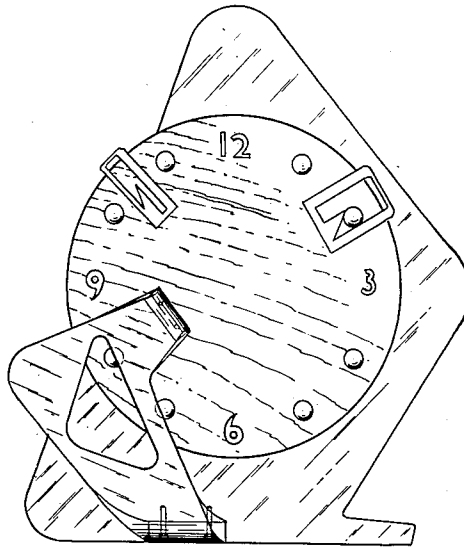

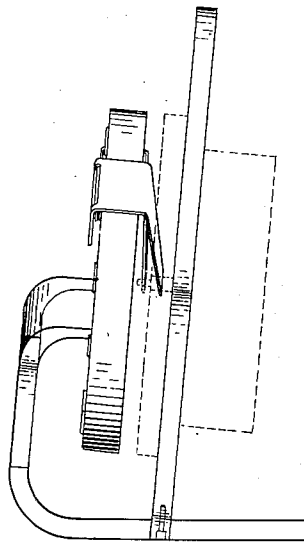

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert Cyril Glorieux, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newton, in the county of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Clock Frame or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a clock frame or similar article, showing my new design; Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the design.

The essential features of my design are shown in full lines.
