

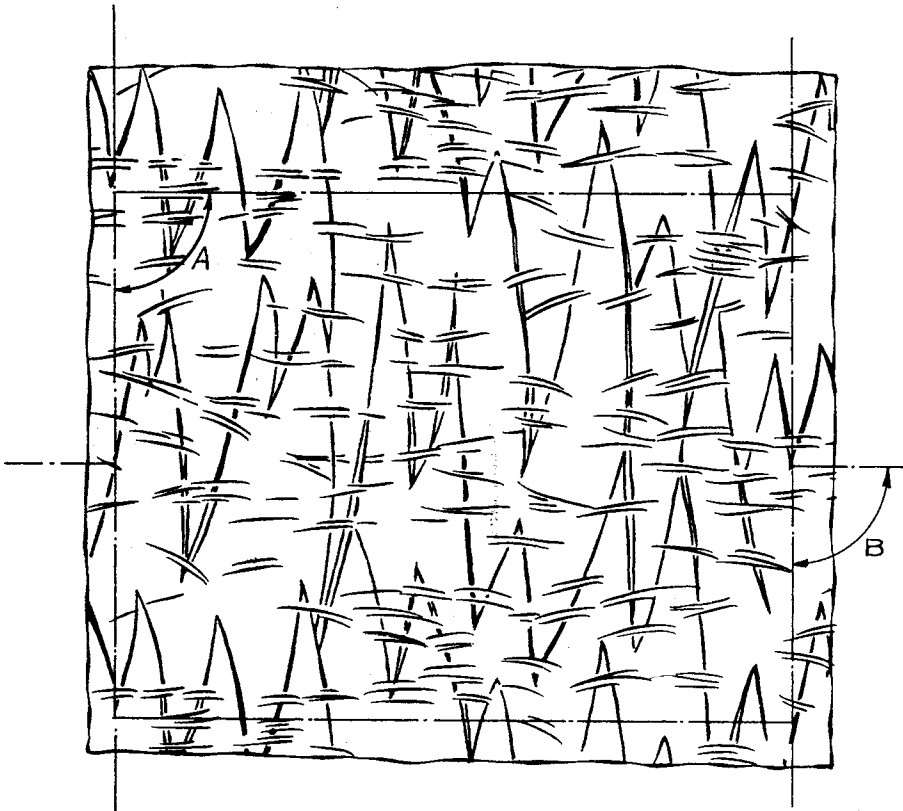

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC OR THE LIKE

Application filed October 11, 1932. Serial No. 45,289. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGES MEGROZ, a citizen of the United States, residing in Bronxville, Westchester County, New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric or the like, showing my new design.

The dot and dash lines on the drawing outline the design unit, which unit is repeated in staggered succession, as indicated by the angles A and B.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric or the like substantially as shown and described.
