

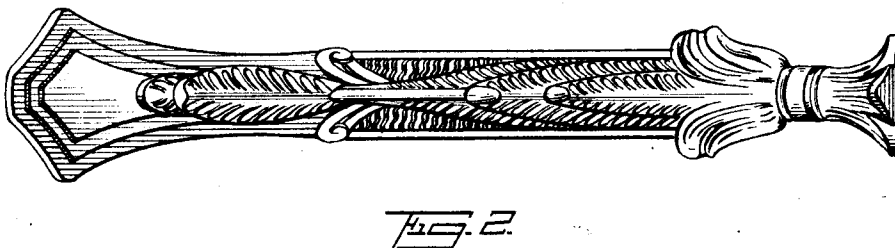
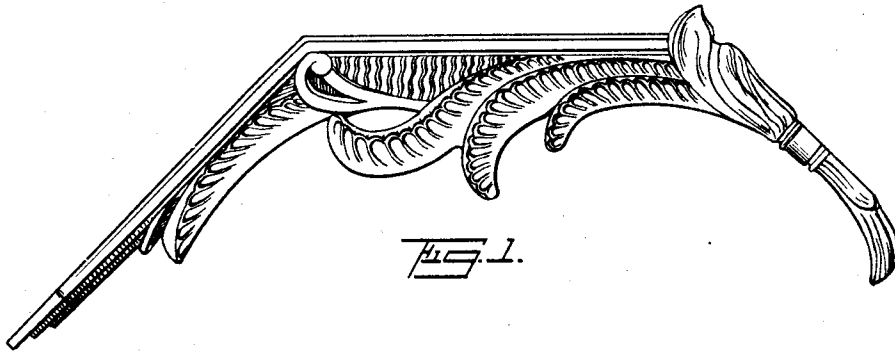

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING-FIXTURE ARM OR ARTICLE OF ANALOGOUS NATURE.

Application filed April 30, 1929. Serial No. 31,055. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN DI GAUDIO, a citizen of the United States of America, and a resident of Brooklyn, county of Kings, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lighting-Fixture Arm or Article of Analogous Nature, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.
