We claim the ornamental design for a quarter round cable cover, as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.


The quarter round cable cover is shown with a symbolic break in its length. The appearance of any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.










