FIG. 8 is an orthographic projection thereof;

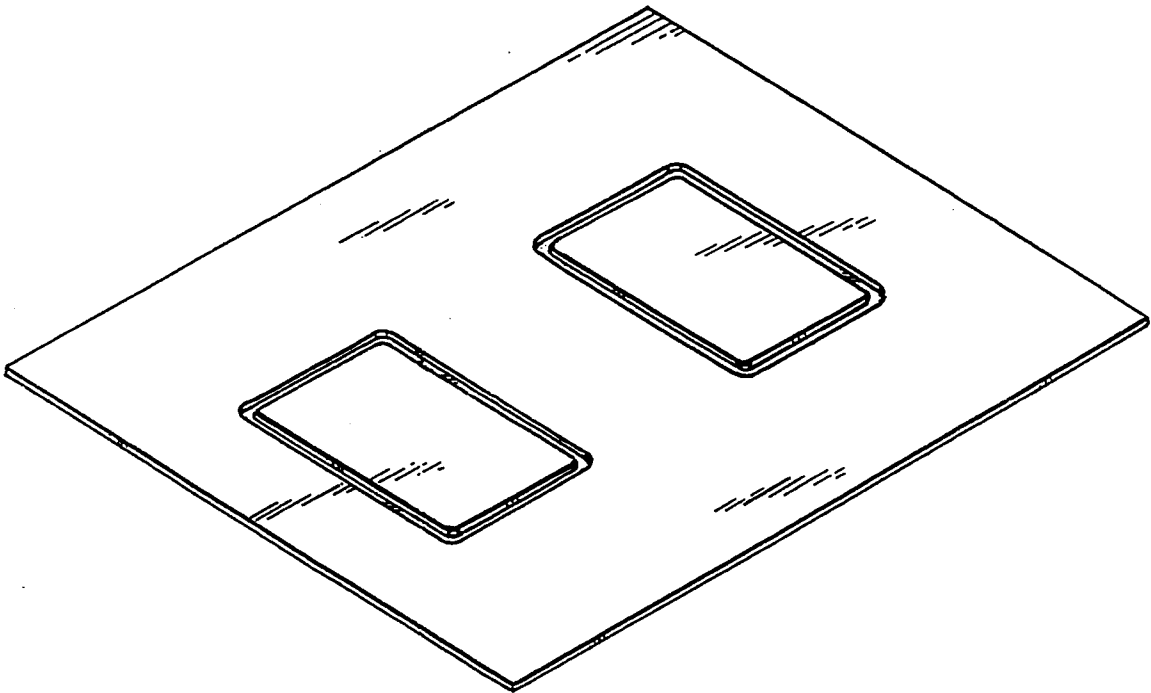
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a second embodi-

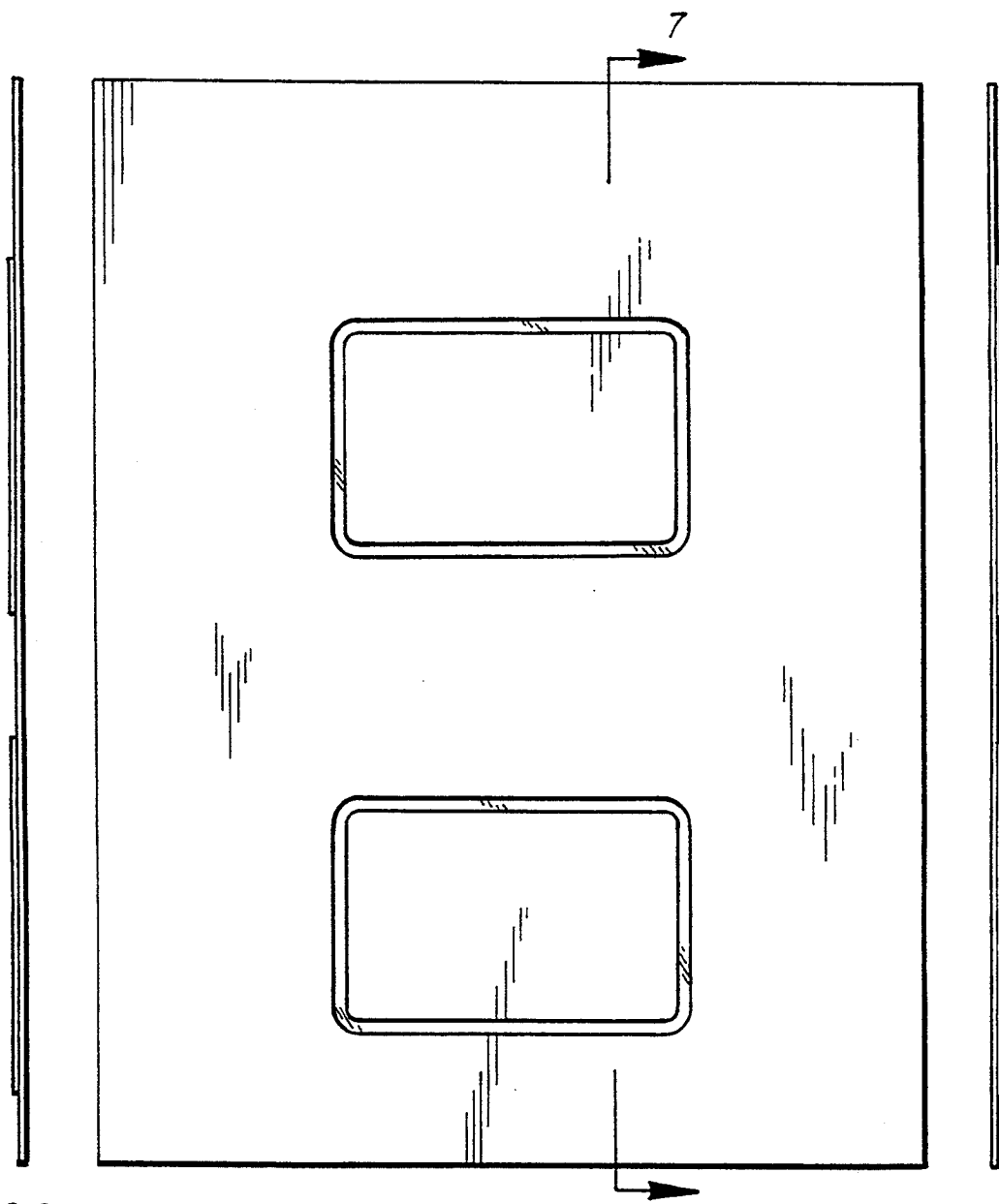

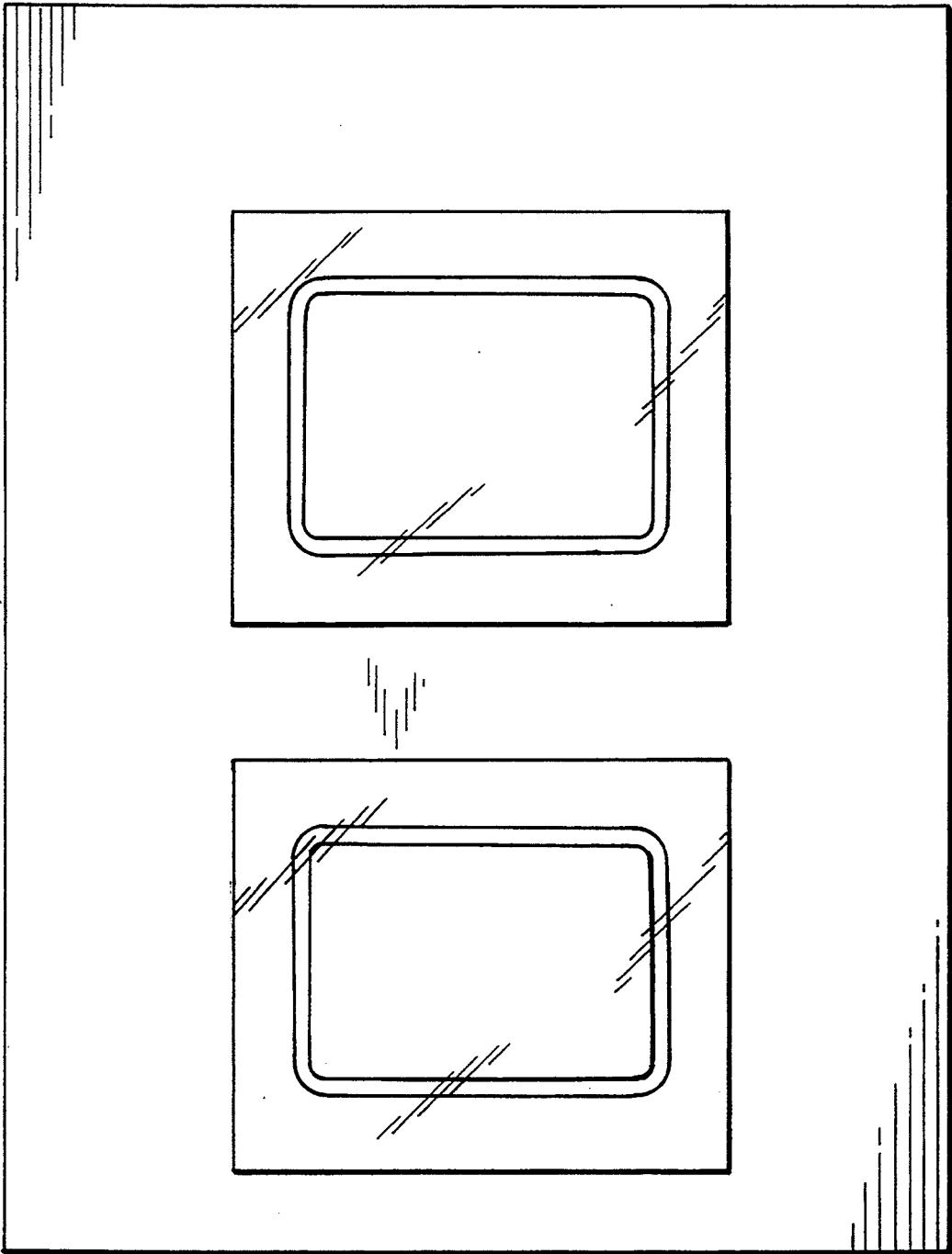

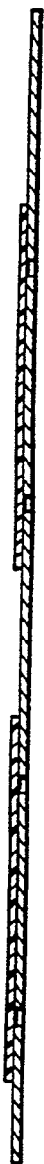

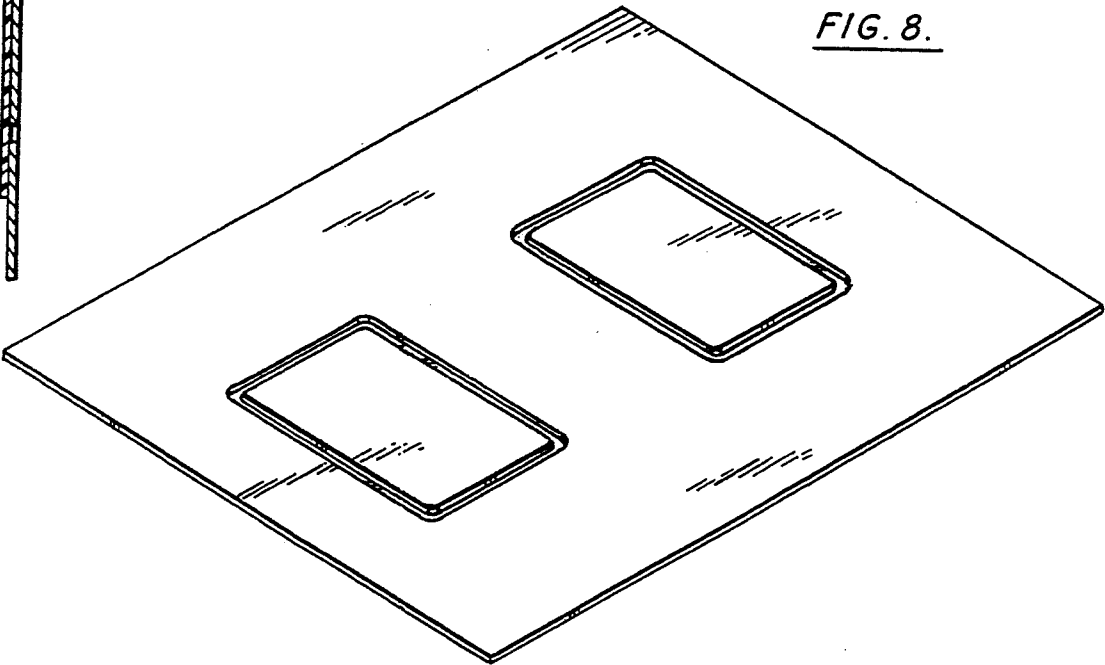

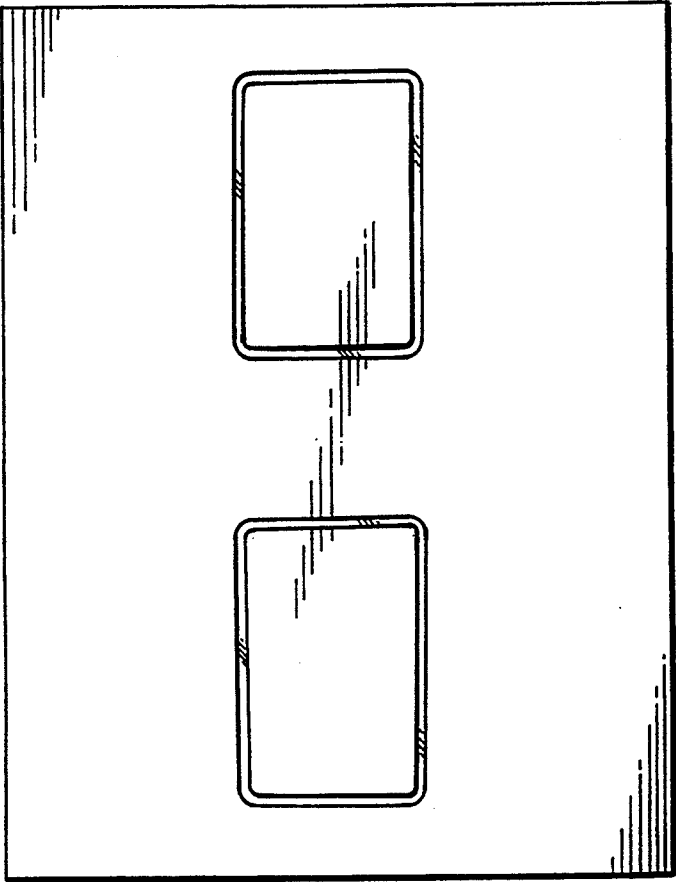

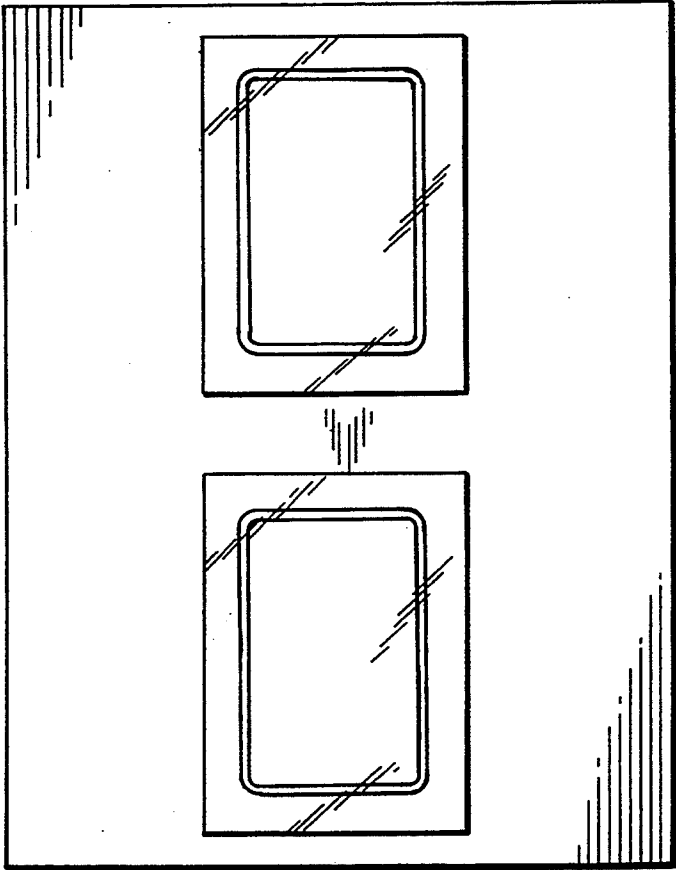

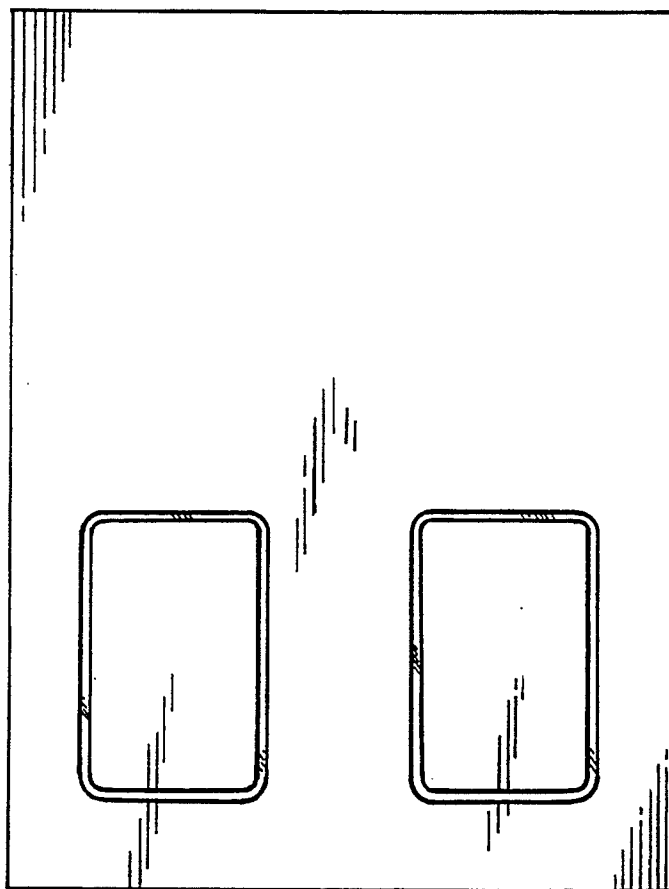
