## DESIGN FOR PRINTING-TYPE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 7,230, dated March 3, 1874; application filed January 5, 1871.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM H. PAGE, of Norwich, in New London county and State of Connecticut, have invented a Design for Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying printed illustration, to which reference is made.

This design consists of a Gothic letter with shade, and having an inside panel sunk into the face of the letter, which is also shaded, thus leaving a narrow raised border around the outside and inside of the letters. These letters also have their curved parts upon

their outer sides beveled in an octagonal form, while the inner parts remain curved, as shown in the letter C, thus presenting a new combination of beveled and round parts, and different, in this respect, from the ordinary Grecian.

I claim as my invention—

The design for an alphabet of letters with shade, and having a shaded panel upon their face, round inside, but beveled upon the outside, substantially as herein shown and described.
