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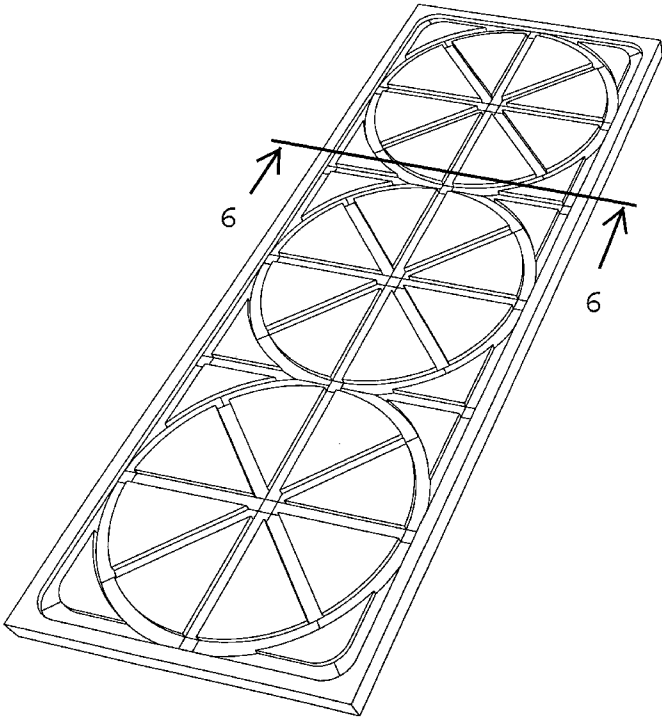

What I claim as my invention is the ornamental design for a trace-to-type character input template, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of trace-to-type character input template showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a perspective cross-sectional view thereof.

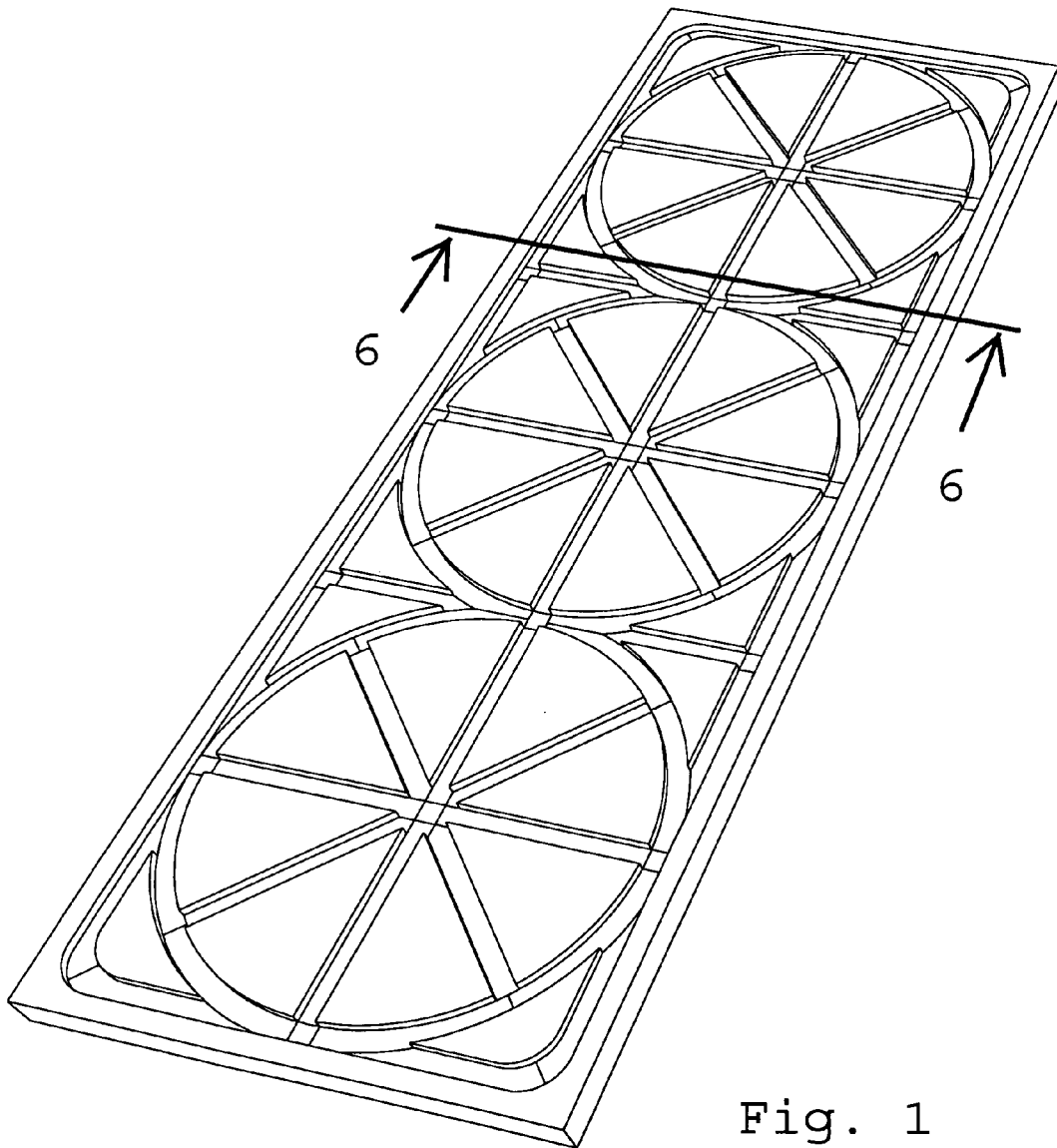

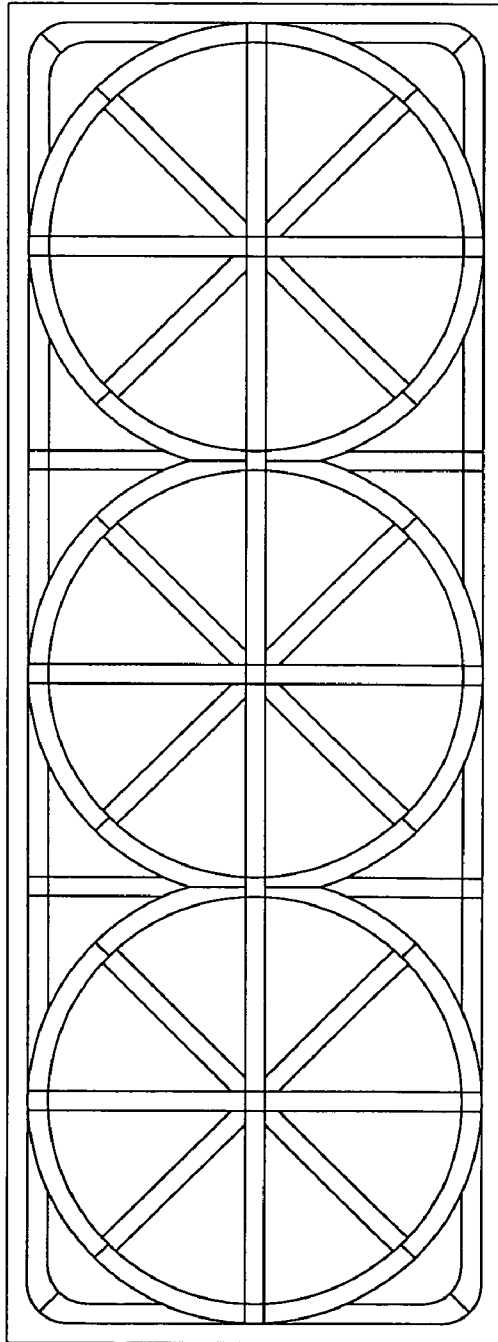

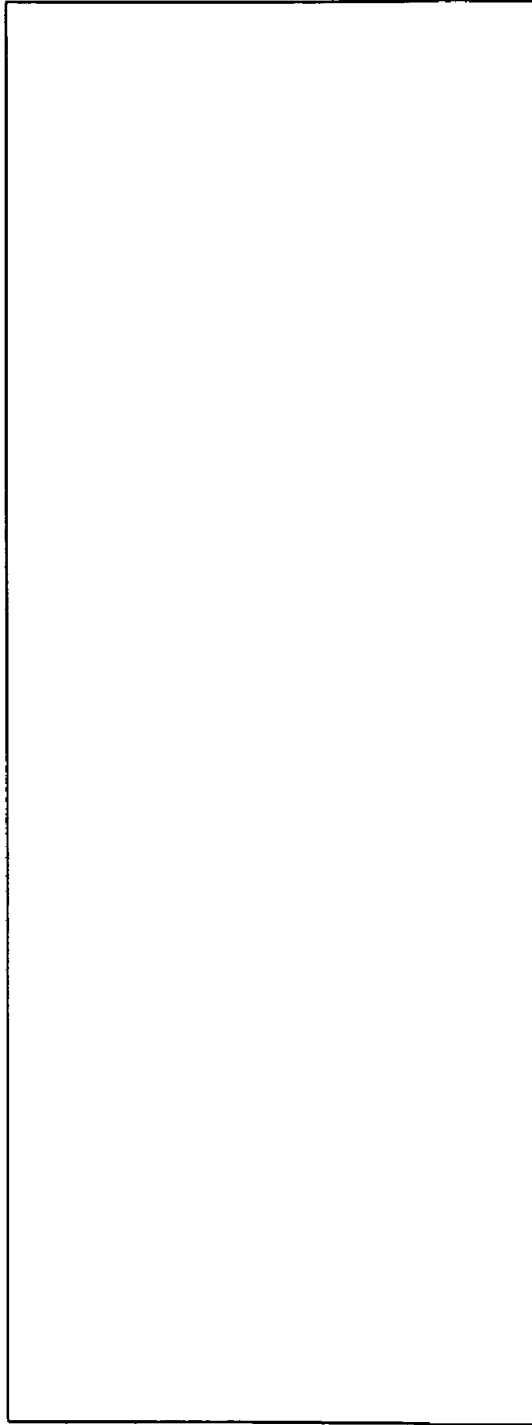

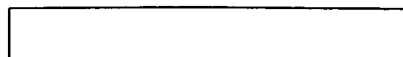

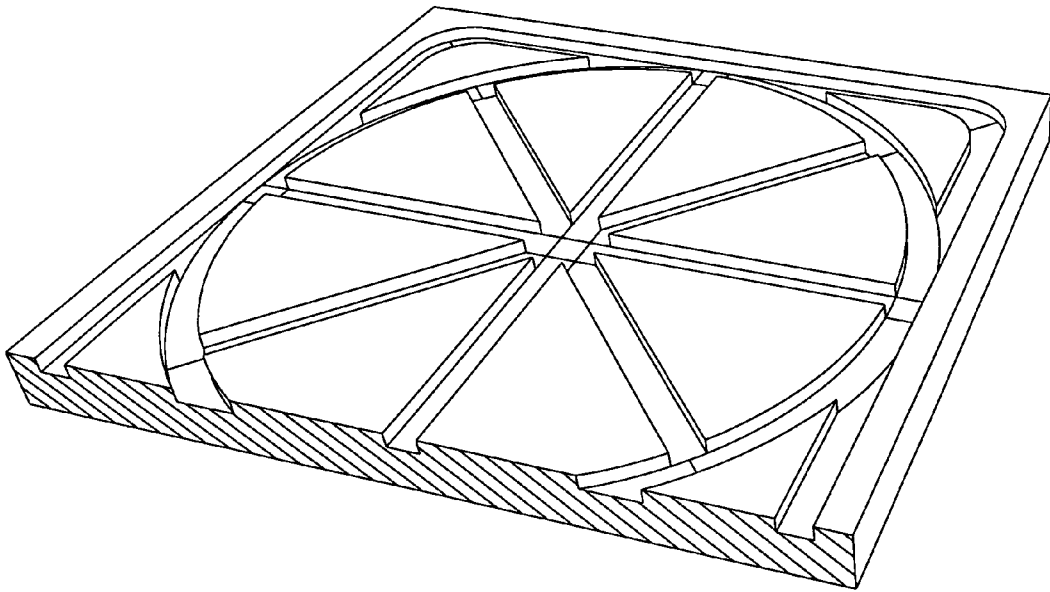
