


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID FRISHMAN, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, New York county, and New York State, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Ash-Holder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, and in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevation of an ash holder showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a front view of the same.
