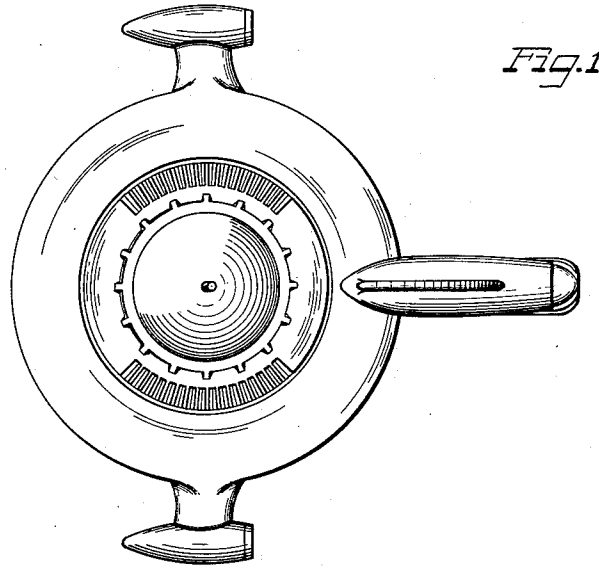

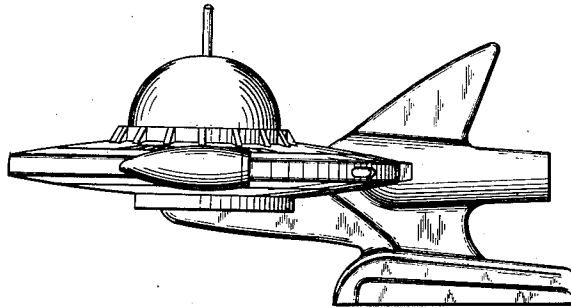
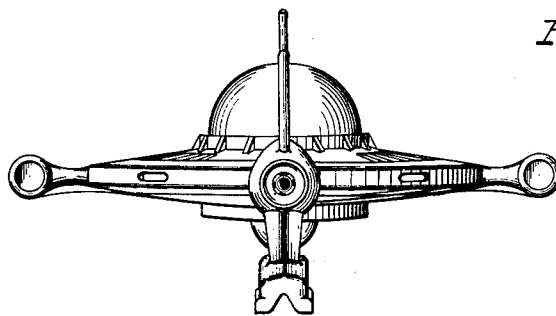

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Alexander S. Tremulis, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Ypsilanti, in the county of Washtenaw and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Automobile Hood Ornament or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

On the drawing:

Figure 1 is a top plan view of an automobile hood ornament constructed in accordance with my invention;

Figure 2 is a view in side elevation of the ornament shown in Figure 1; and

Figure 3 is a front end view of the ornament shown in Figure 1.
