

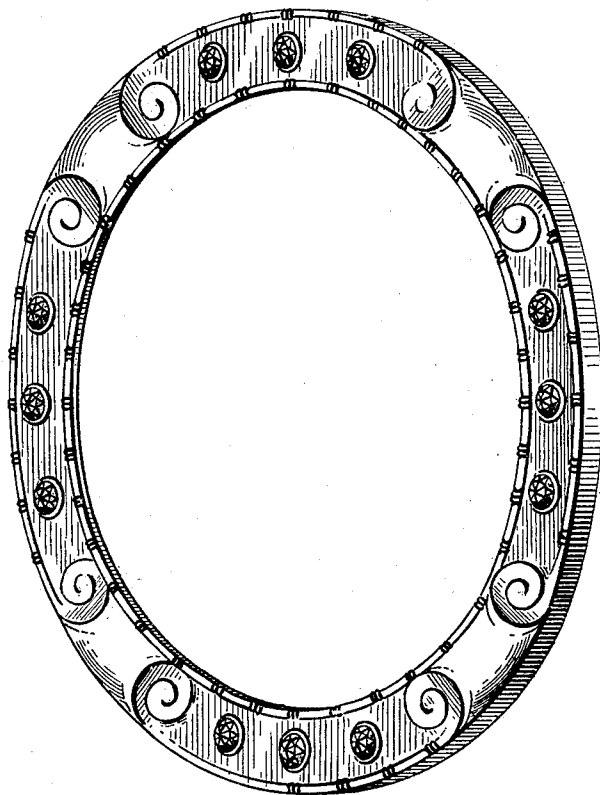

## DESIGN FOR A SIGN-FRAME.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,818, dated February 23, 1904.

Application filed December 27, 1900. Serial No. 41,290. Term of patent 7 years.
