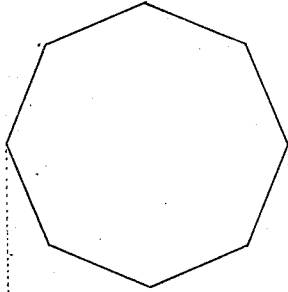

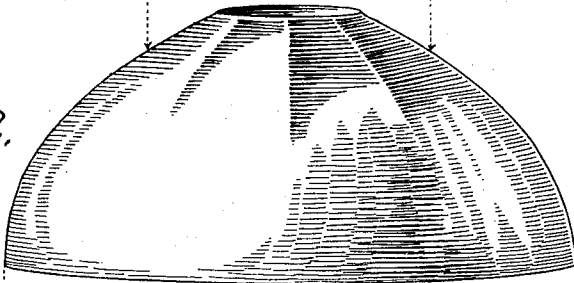

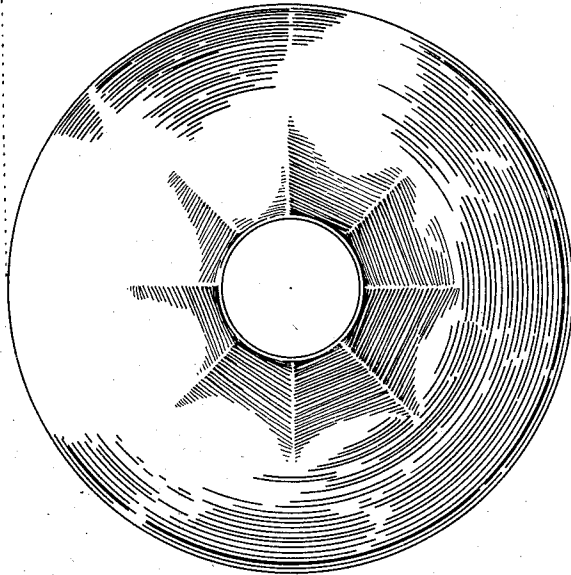

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM F. HANDEL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Meriden, in the county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shade for Lighting-Fixtures, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of my shade for lighting fixtures. Fig. 2 is a side perspective of the same. Fig. 3 is a section of Fig. 2 taken on the line indicated by the arrow heads.
