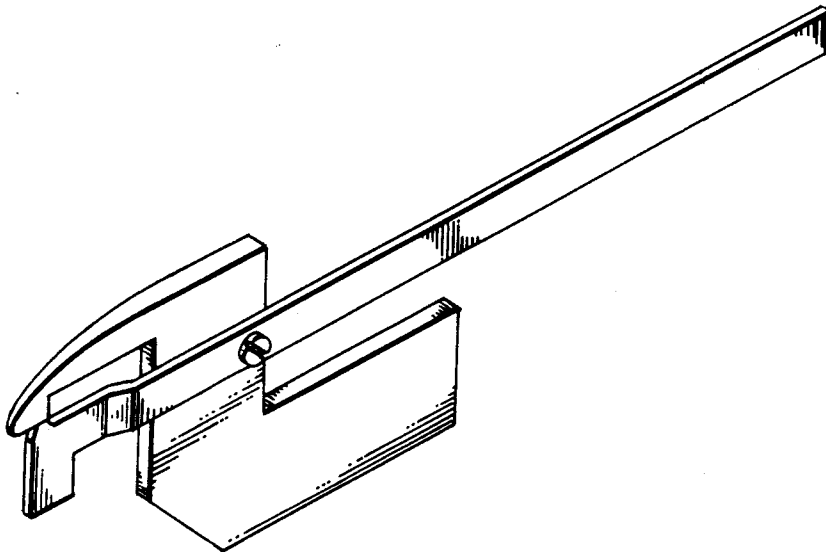

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a gated hook for tufting machines, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a gated hook for tufting machines showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left end elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right end elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



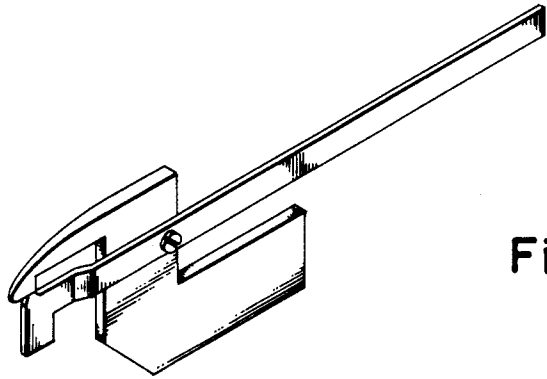

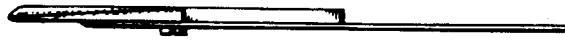

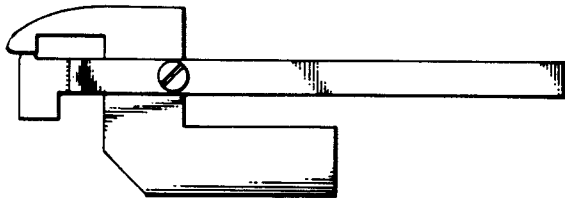

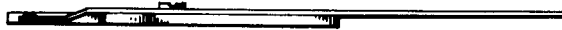
