The ornamental design for a power surge protector, as shown and described.

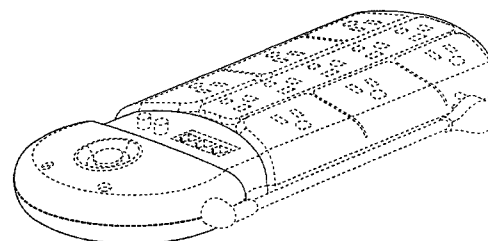
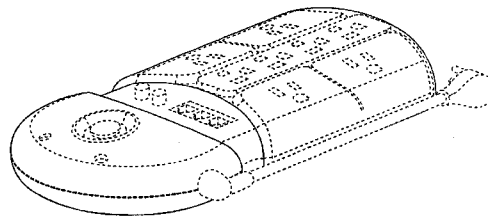
**DESCRIPTION**

The present design application relates to the applicants copending U.S. Pat. application Ser. No. 10/411,493, filed Apr. 10, 2003.

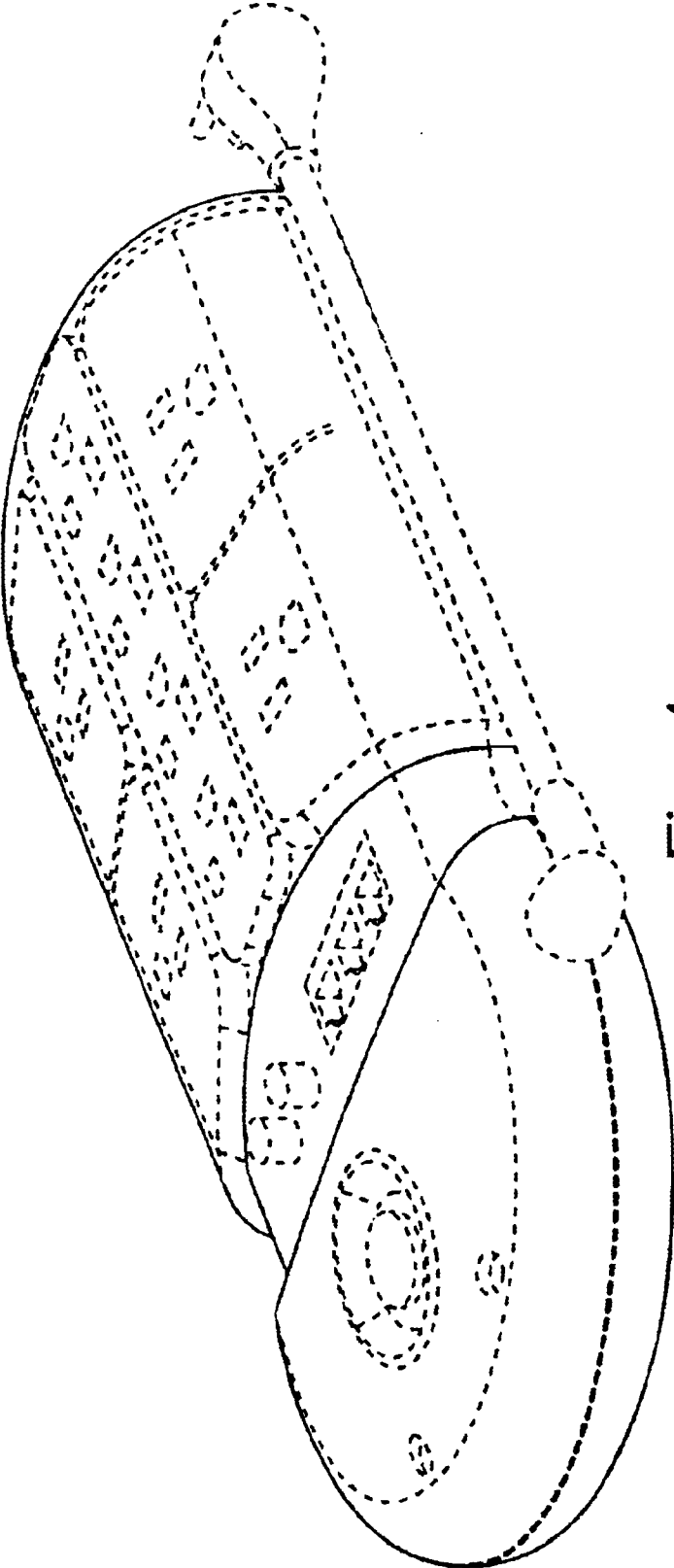

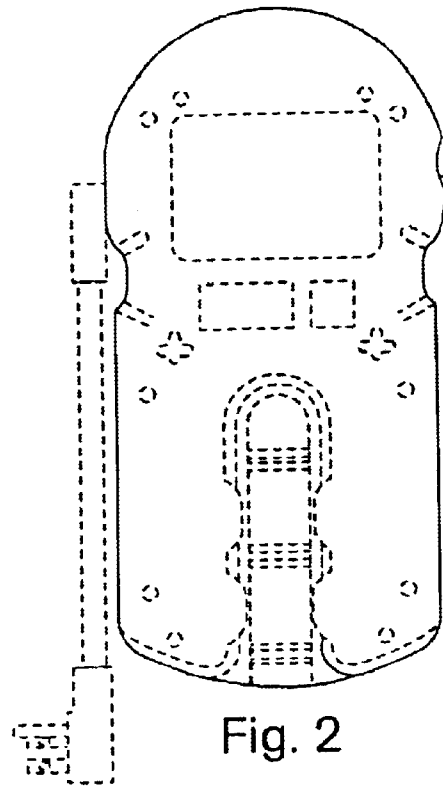

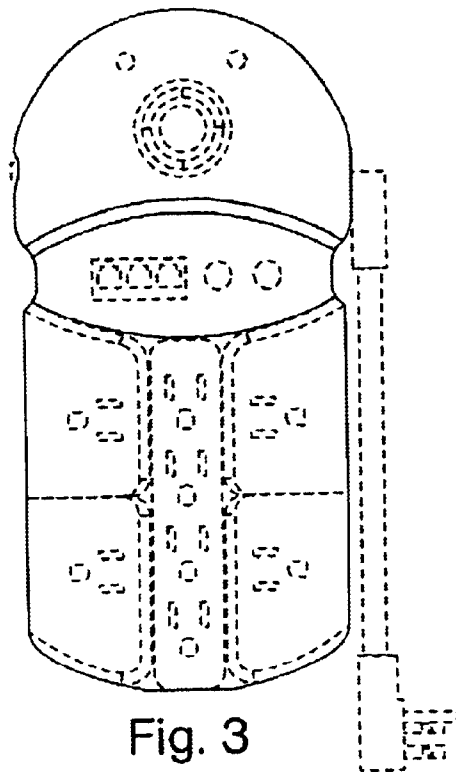

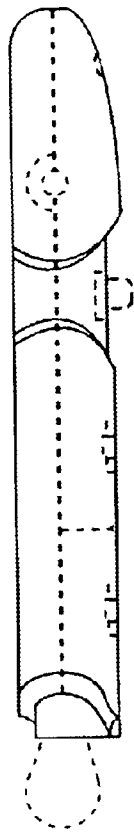

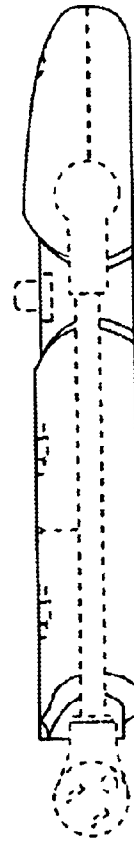

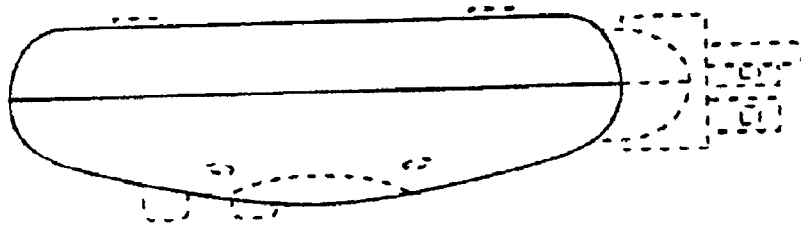

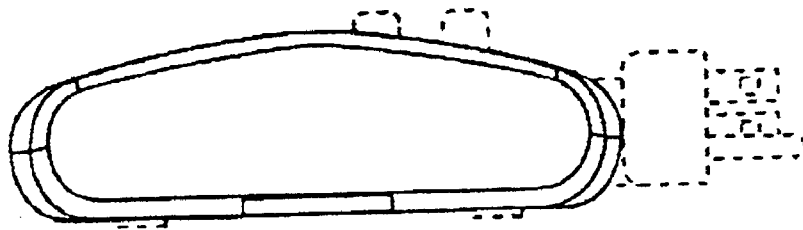

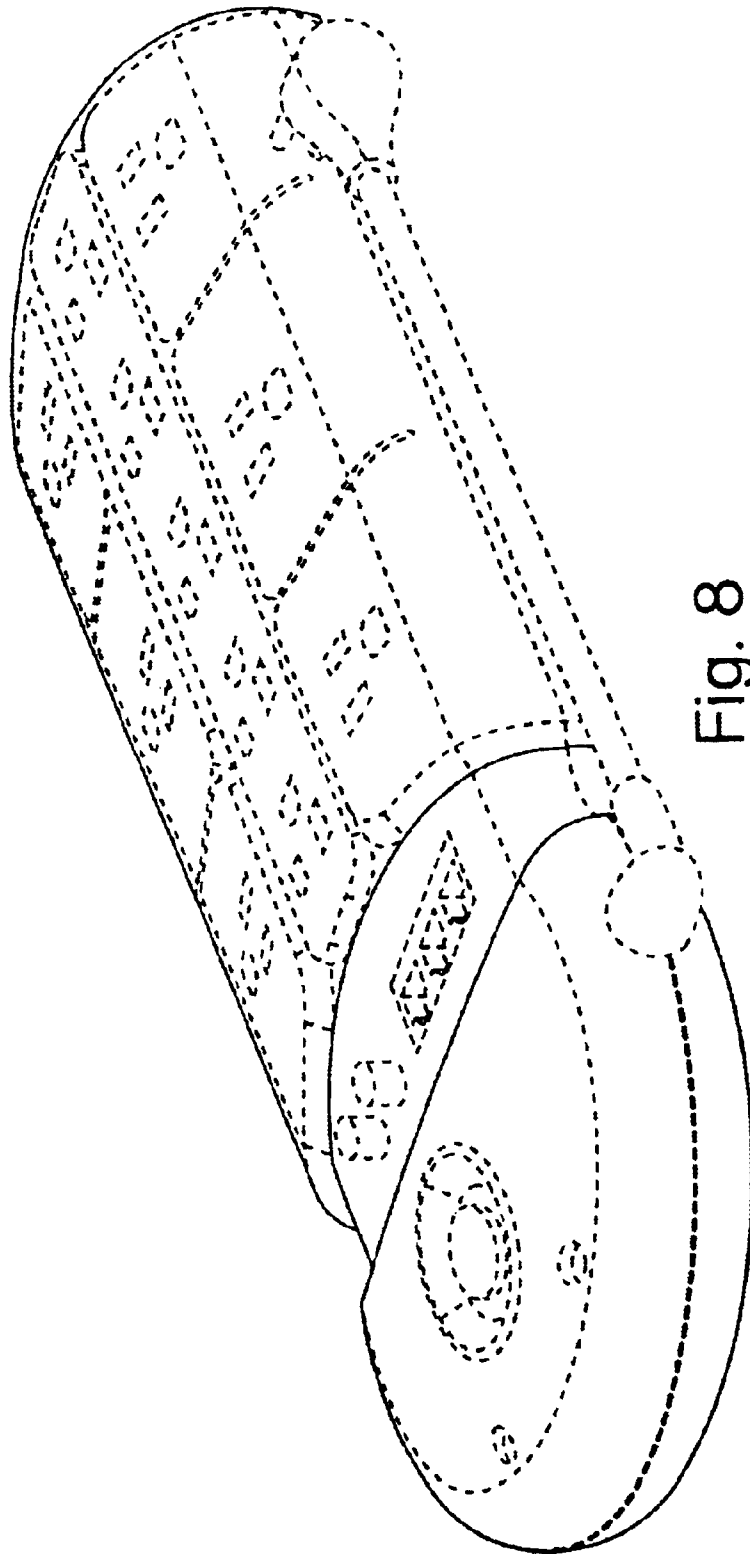
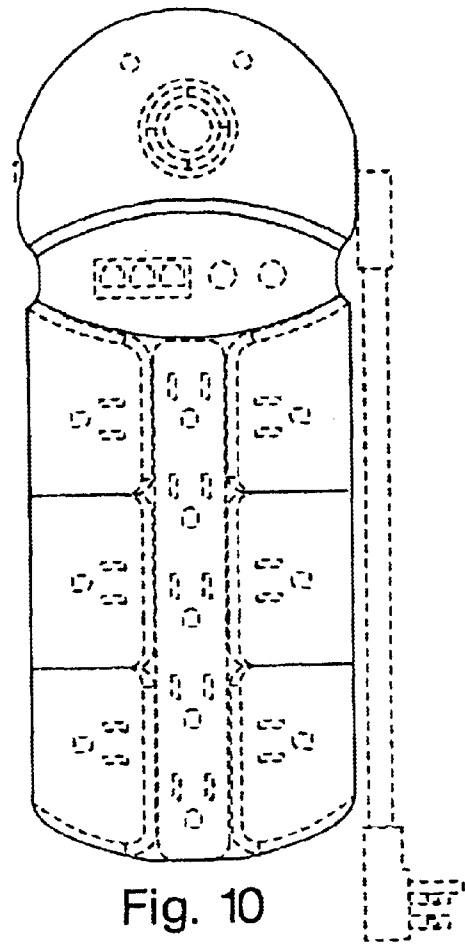
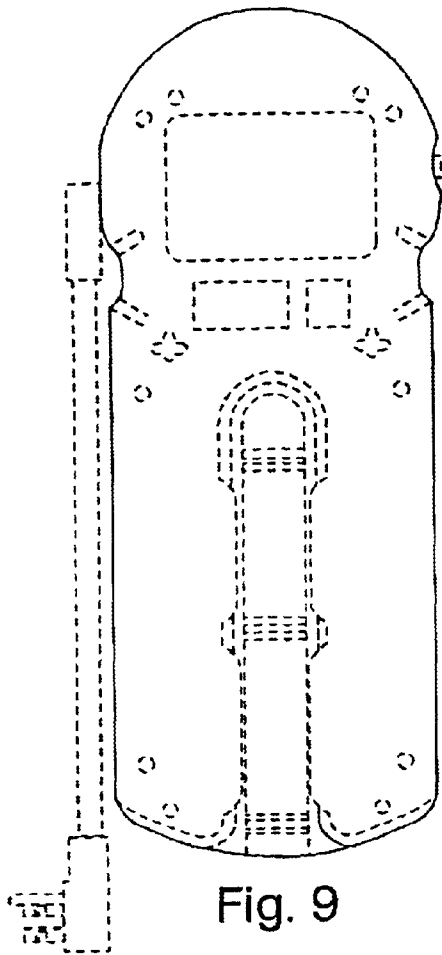

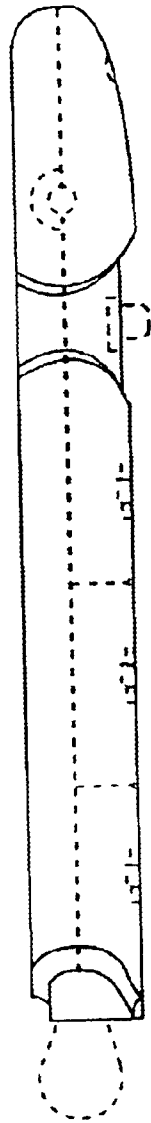

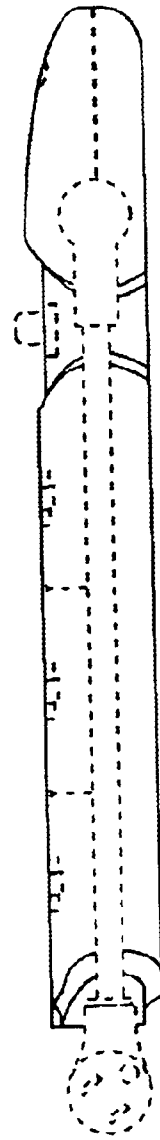

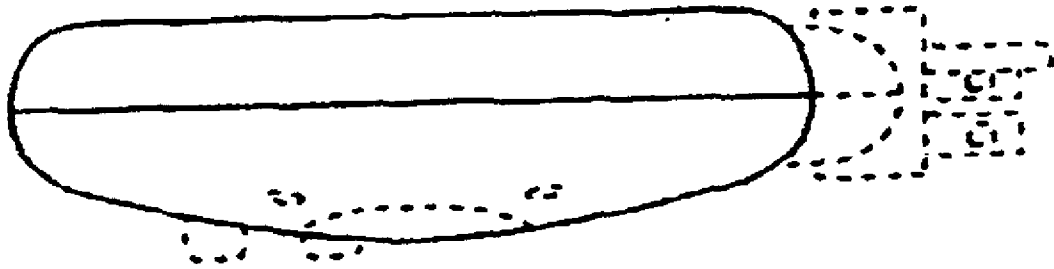

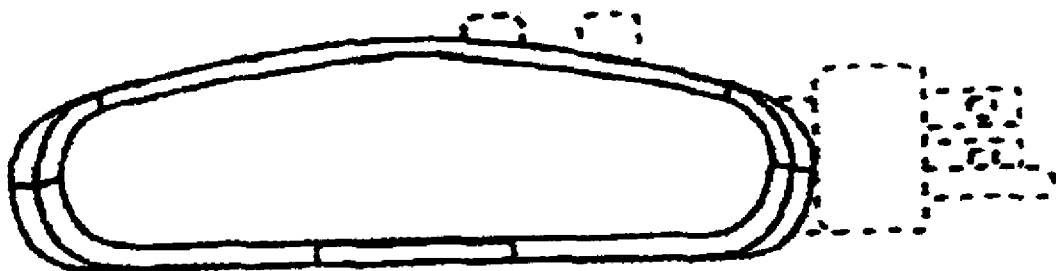
