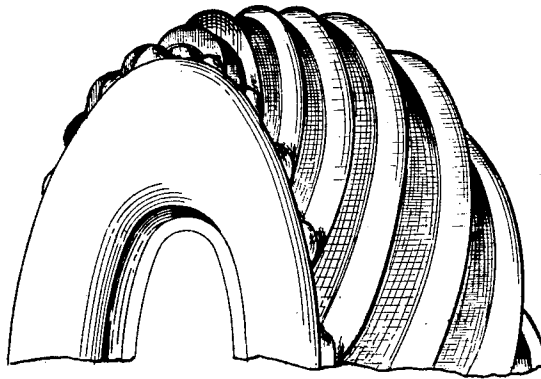

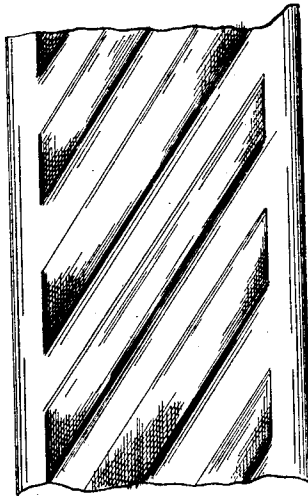

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOHN W. RICHARDSON, a citizen of the United States, residing at Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tire, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a portion of the tire, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a plan view of a portion of the tread.
