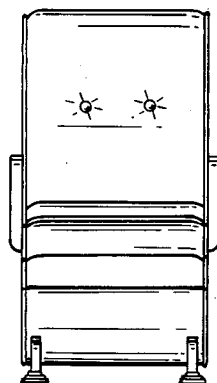
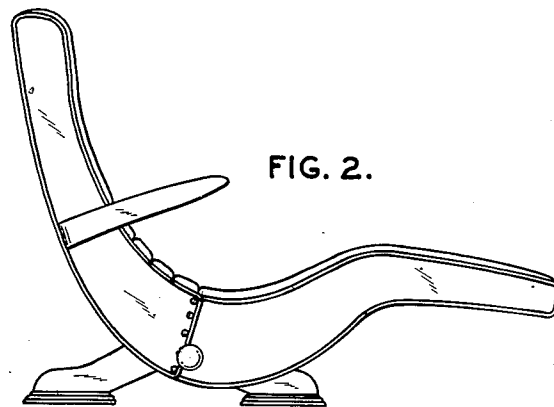
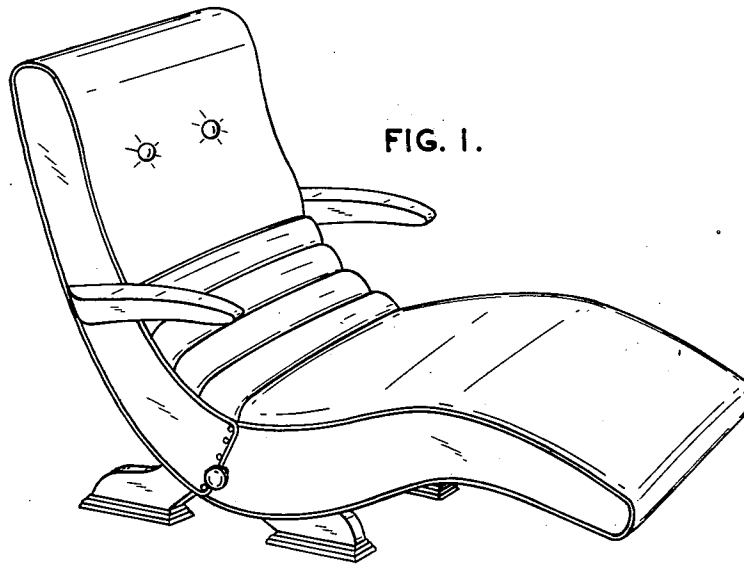

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that we, Max Manne and Jesse T.
