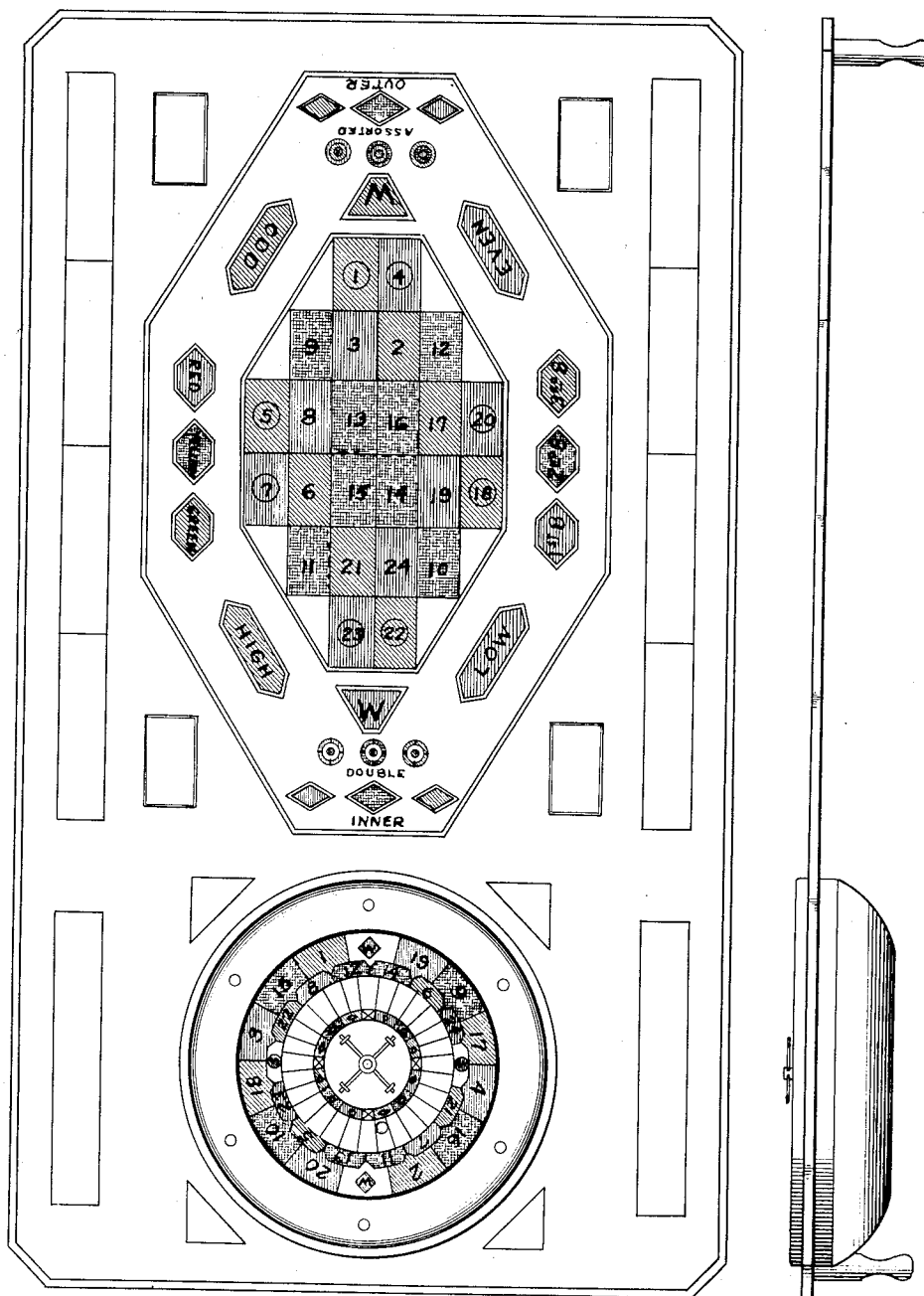

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Richard W. Danon, a citizen of the United States and a resident of the city of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combination Game Board and Apparatus or Similar Article, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
