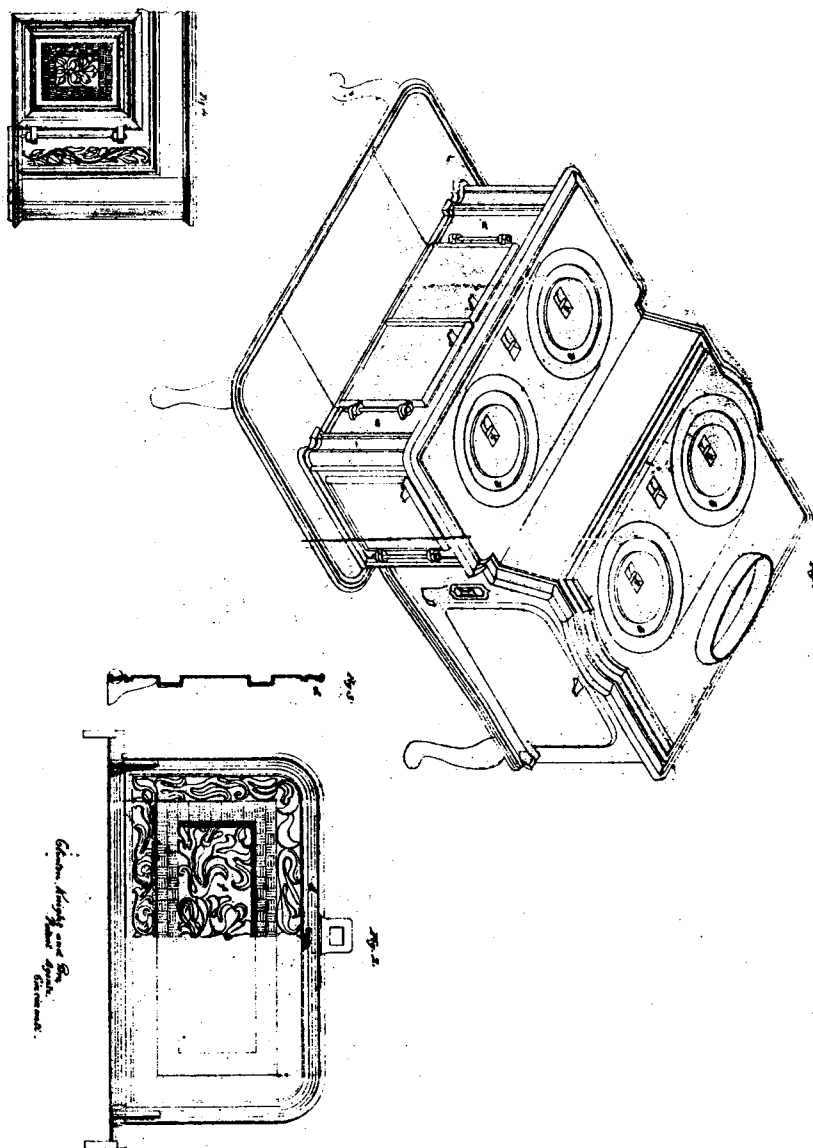

The schedule referred to in these letters patent and making part of the same

To all whom it may concern: Be it known that J. W. Burton, of Cincinnati, Hamilton Co, Ohio, have invented or produced a new combination of Ornamental designs and configuration for a cooking stove, represented in the annexed drawings making a part of this specification in which Fig. 1. exhibits in perspective the general configuration of the stove. Fig. 2. is a front view of the oven door. Fig. 3. is a vertical section of the same. Fig. 4. exhibits the style of scroll work on the centre panels of the fire doors and on the panel which at one end of the fire place replaces the door & that on the front plate at each side (a) of the front fire door half of the front only being shown, the other half being counterparts.

The stove is one of what is called the Premium form having the oven back and somewhat elevated from the fire chamber.

The decorations on the various doors are similar to those represented in Figs 2 & 3. on the oven door in which (d) is a moulding consisting of a succession of beads flutes and fillets which follow the outline

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of the door. from the edge inwards. Some distance within this, is a raised square fillet (e) checkered with flutes as shown both within (f) and around this fillet is scroll work, of which the half is represented the other half being a counterpart.

The fire doors and panel have no scroll work between the outside border and the raised fillet but have scroll work (h. Fig. 4.) within the fillet. (i. Fig. 4) shows the scroll ornament which is on each side the front fire door at (a. Fig. 1.)

Having thus fully described and represented the configuration and decorations of my Ornamental Design for a cooking Stove - and disclaiming the mere details of ornaments separately taken

What I claim as my design a production and desire to secure by letters patent is the combination of moulding and other ornaments as applied substantially according to the description of the several doors panels &c
