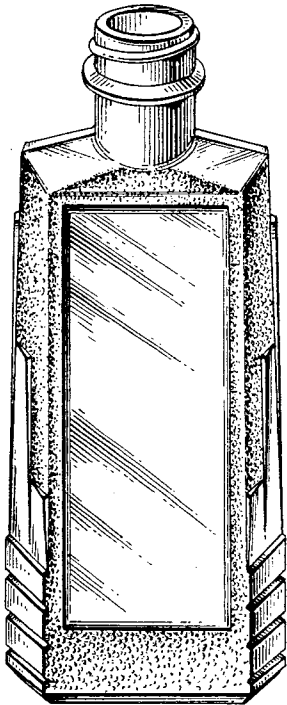
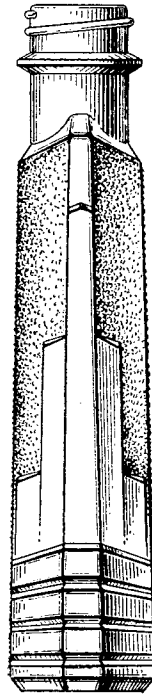

DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LOUIS PAUL GREY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Zanesville, in the county of Muskingum and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
