

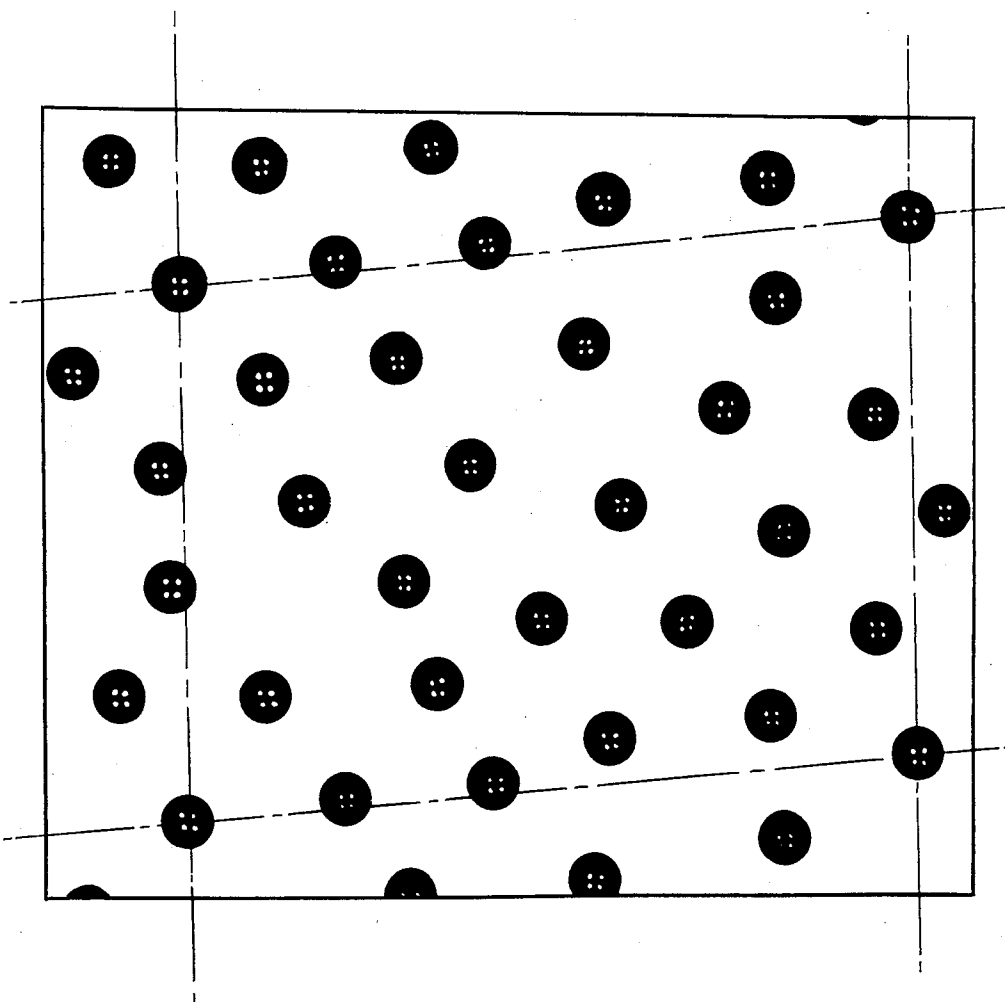

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Marcel Christen, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, in the Borough of Manhattan, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein the figure is a plan view of a piece of textile fabric

showing my new design. The dot and dash lines on the drawing outline substantially a design unit, which unit is repeated in regular succession as indicated by the extensions beyond the unit boundaries.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric, substantially as shown and described.
