





To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert W. Shields, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cock and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Binoculars, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of binoculars, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is an edge view thereof;

Fig. 3 is an end elevational view thereof looking at the larger end of the binoculars;

Fig. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, and

Fig. 5 is an end elevational view looking at the smaller end of the binoculars.
