IMPROVED LINIMENT FOR RHEUMATISM.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 82,696, dated October 6, 1868.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, A. M. DENNEN, of Folsom City, in the county of Sacramento and State of California, have invented a new and useful Improvement in Liniment for Rheumatism; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, which will enable others skilled in the art to make and use the same.

The object of this invention is to provide a medical compound which is an effective remedy in treating rheumatism by topical application

It is composed of equal parts, by weight, of the following: Oil of wormwood, oil of cassia, oil of hemlock, oil of tansy, oil of lavender, oil of anise, oil of cloves, oil of origanum, oil

of tar, tar-balsam, gum-opii, and gum-myrrh, with enough alcohol to make the above ingredients into a fluid mixture or liniment.

This liniment is an excellent palliative for chronic rheumatism, and will be found to remove ordinary cases of acute rheumatism.

Having thus described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

The medical compound, substantially as herein described.
