

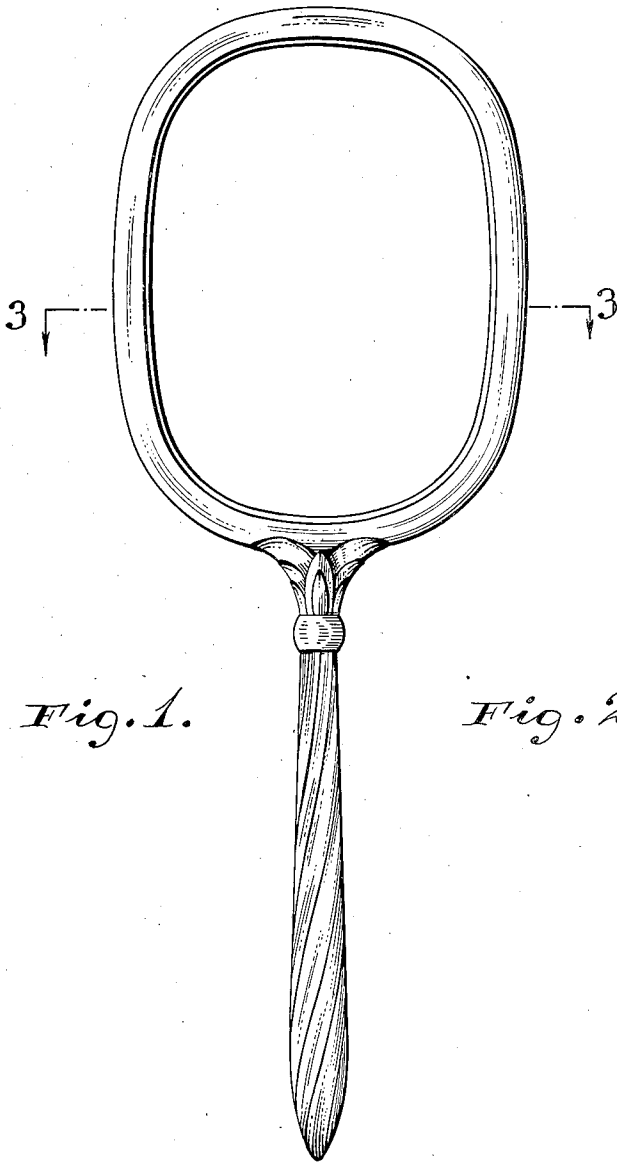

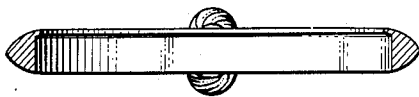

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Leo Marder, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Frame for a Hand Mirror or Similar Article, as shown, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of a frame for a hand mirror or similar article showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

Figure 3 is a section taken on the line 3—3 of Figure 1.

In the drawing, the head of the frame is shown with the back thereof open.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a frame for a hand mirror or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
