DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a sockliner for a shoe showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

The bottom of the sockliner is plain and unornamented.

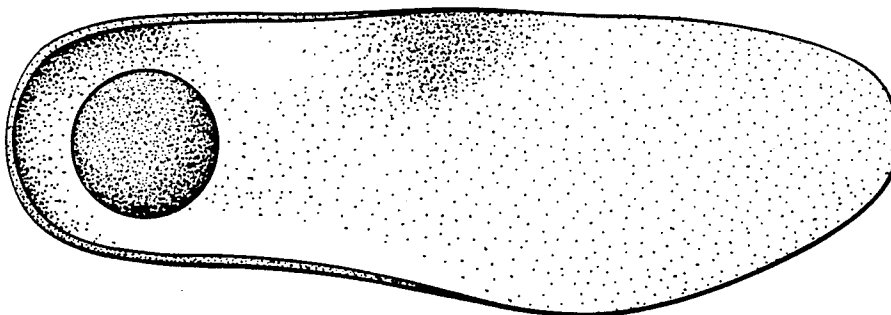

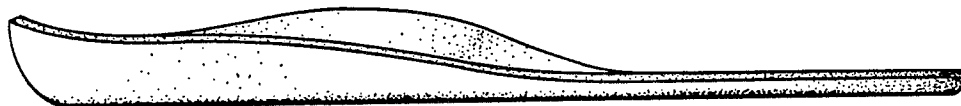

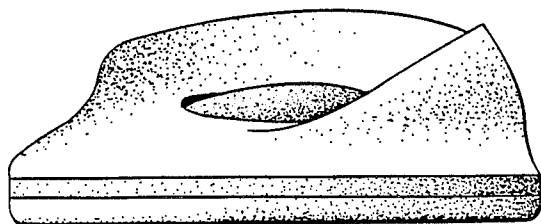
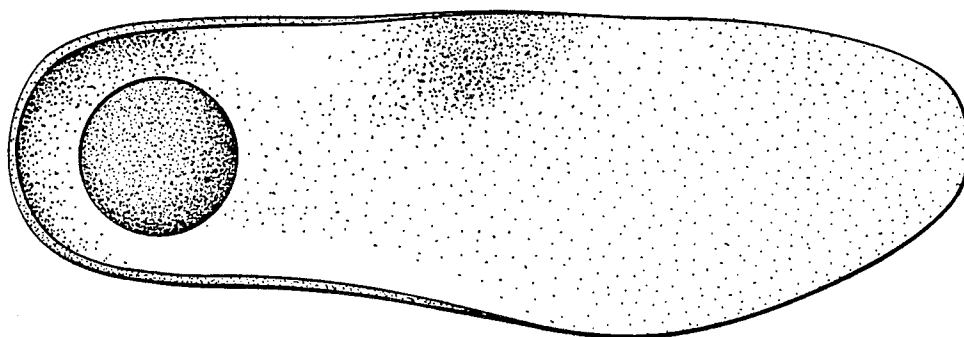
