(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a football memorabilia outdoor torch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the football memorabilia outdoor torch showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of my design.

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of my design.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of my design.

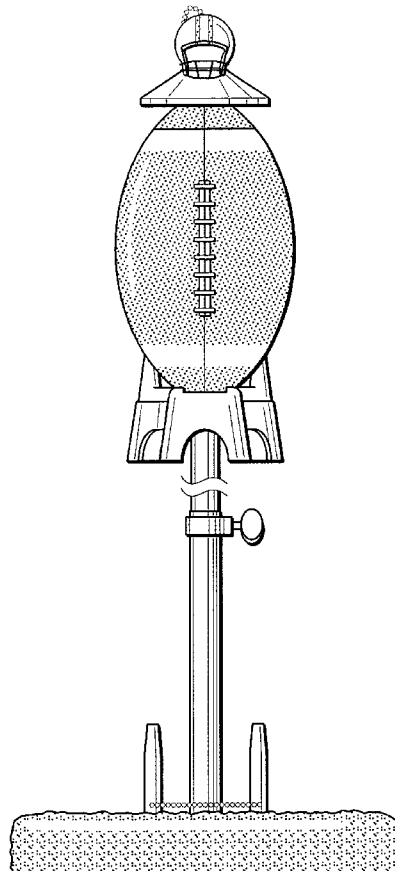
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of my design; and,

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of my design with the cap removed and the torch lighted.

The football torch is shown broken away to indicate it has no particular length.

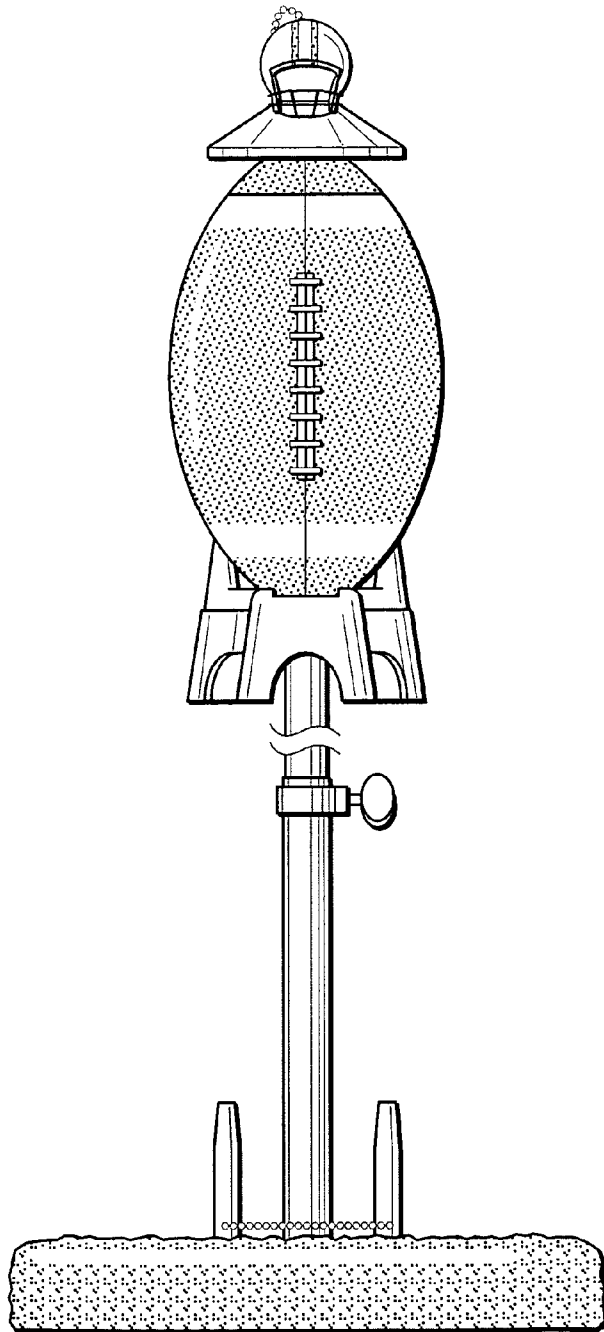

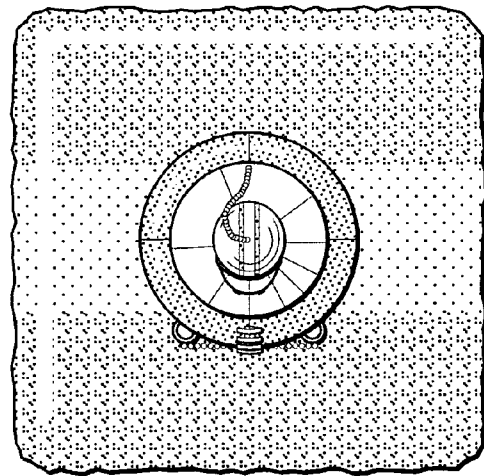
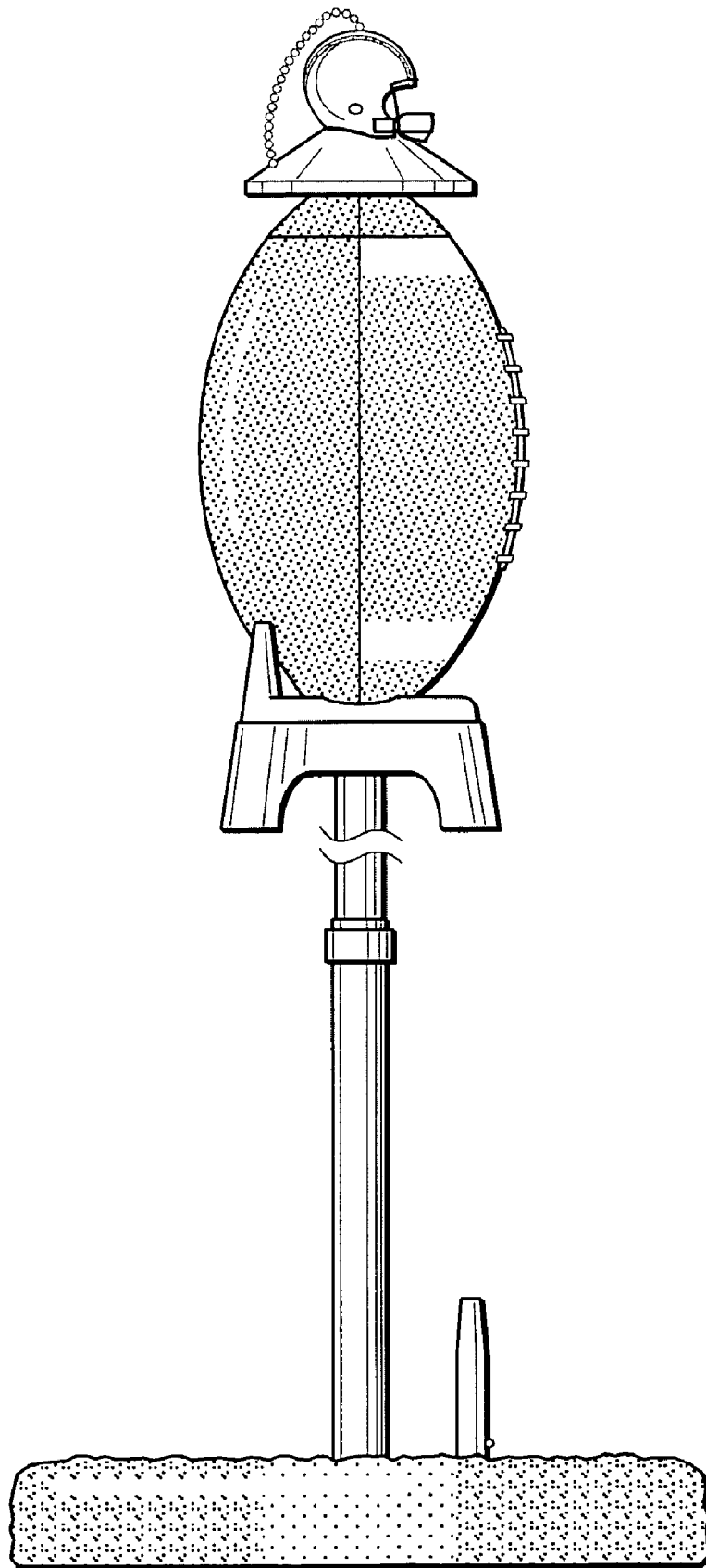

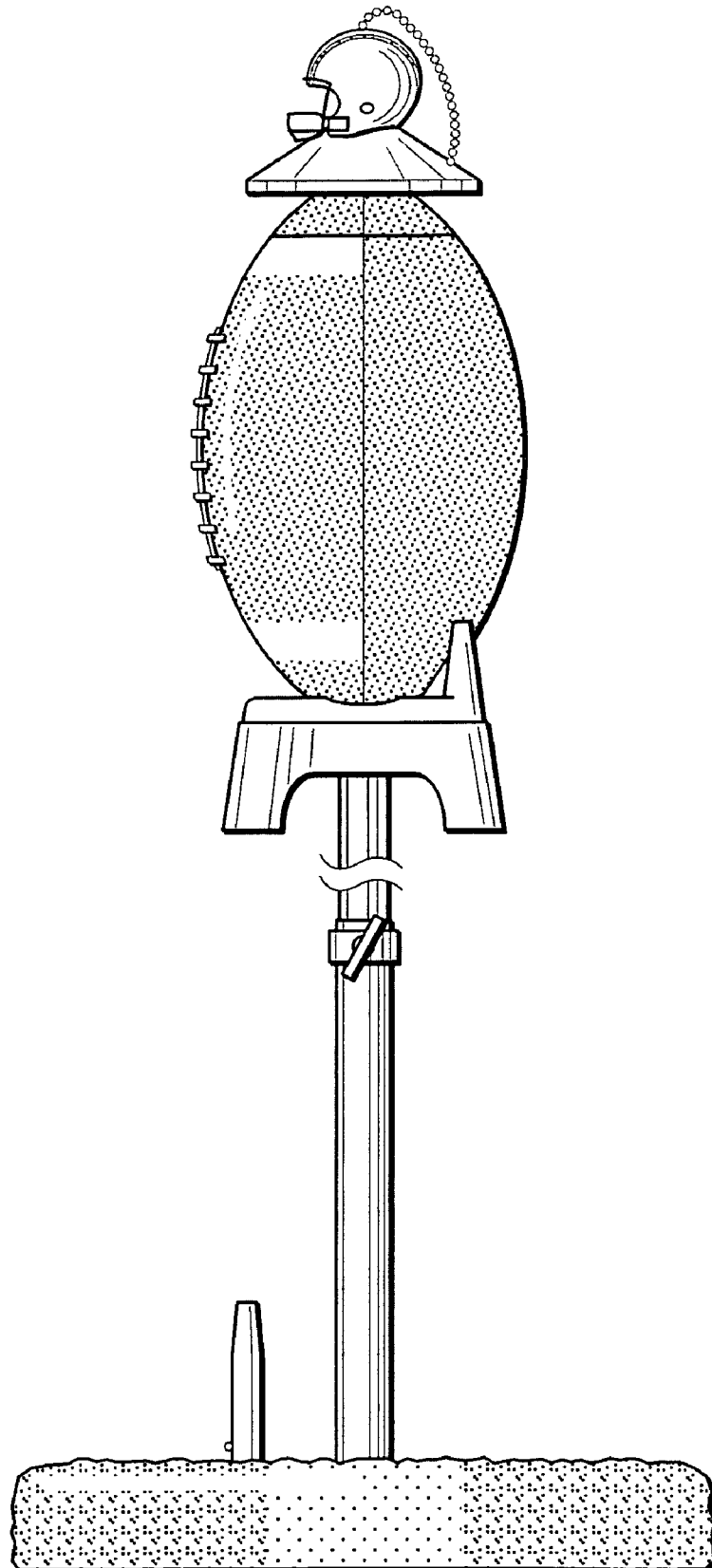

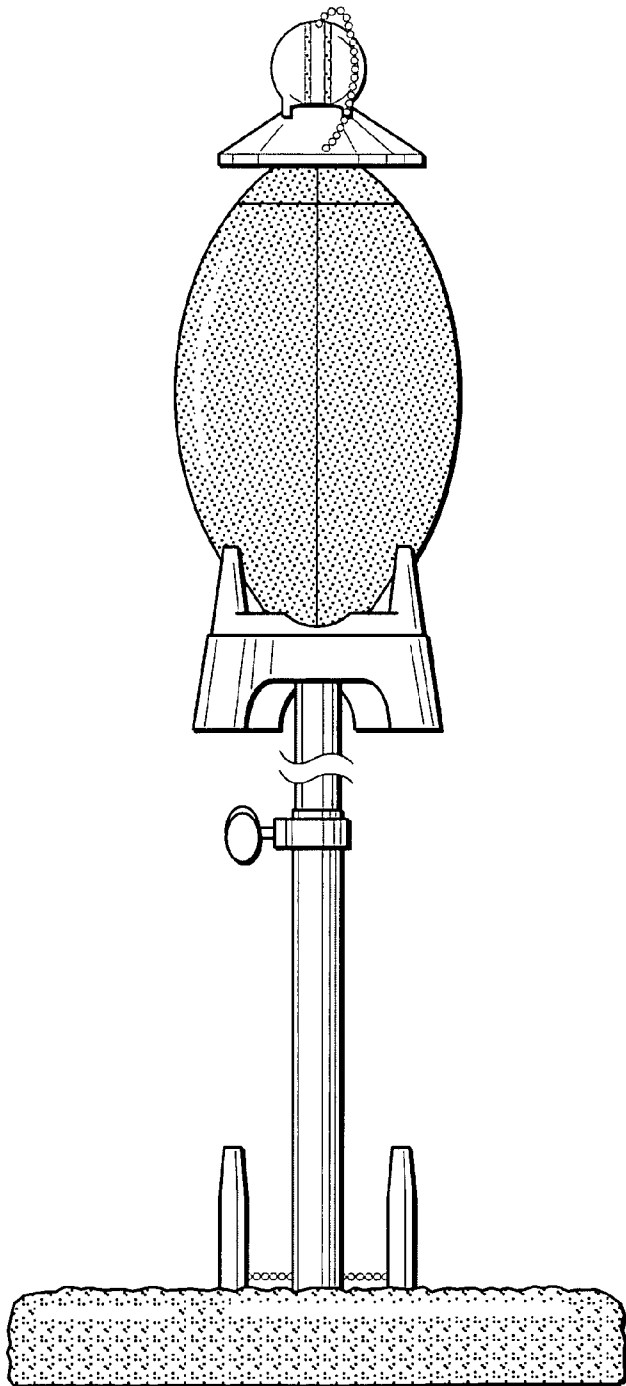

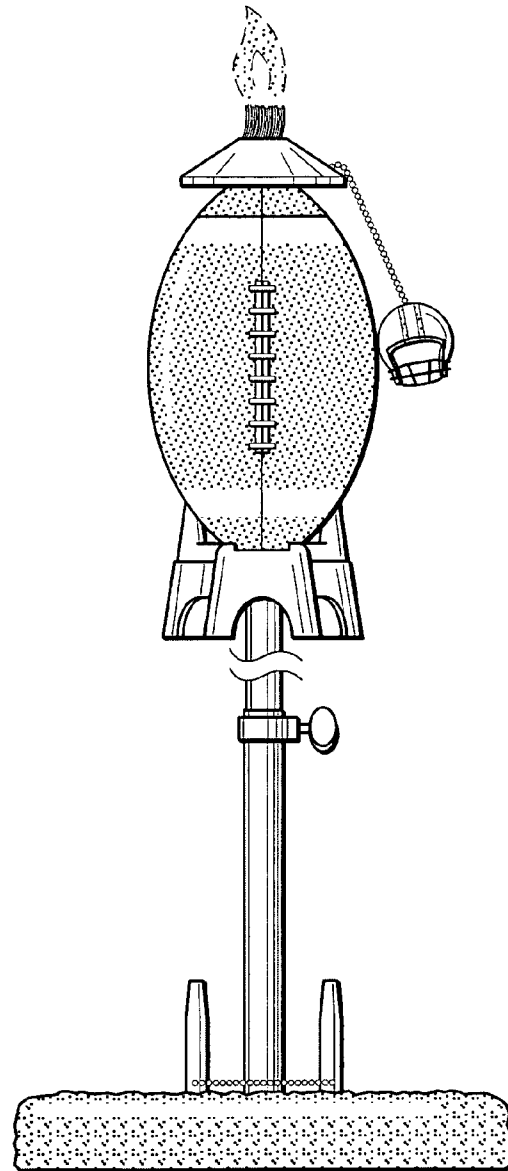
