

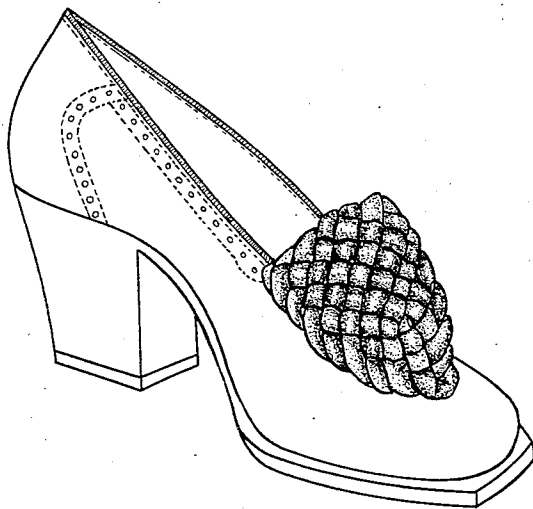

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jacob Sandler, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure on the drawing is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design, the opposite side presenting substantially the same appearance as the side shown.
